Dear Mr. Woodruff:

Filed with this letter are tariff sheets consisting of rate schedules designed to increase Veolia’s base gross annual revenues by approximately \$1 million, or 14.4 percent, exclusive of applicable gross receipts, sales, franchise or occupational fees or taxes.

Also filed with this letter are the tariff sheets described below:

1. Economic Development Rate (“EDR”) tariff to enable customers to transition to Veolia’s system;
2. Capacity Reserve / Emergency Service (“CR/ES”) tariff to serve customers with back-up or emergency needs who primarily draw energy from other sources;
3. Residential High-Rise (“RHR”) tariff to enable service to an additional customer class;
4. Special Contract Steam Service (“SCSS”) tariff to address unique customer circumstances not met by other tariff schedules;
5. Production Adjustment Cost Clause (“PACC”) tariff to account for increasing production costs, enable more effective budgeting, and provide better customer service;
6. Interruptible Heating Service (“IHS”) rate tariff reopened to serve additional customers with aging equipment;

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7. Expanded Tariff Zone adjusting for use and scope of downtown Kansas City;
8. IHS and Large Commercial Service (“LCS”) demand charges rebalanced to assist customer understanding and customer budgeting.

The proposed tariff sheets bear a date of issue of November 27, 2013, and an effective date of December 31, 2013.

The test year used by Veolia is a calendar test year which ended June 30, 2013, recognizing identifiable known and measurable changes generally through December 31, 2013.

Veolia’s rate increase filing is occasioned by an increase in its costs to provide regulated steam services. Veolia has filed additional tariffs to serve customer needs more effectively and to more equitably distribute costs among customers.

As required by 4 CSR 240-2.065(1), also provided are the direct Testimony and schedules of the following Veolia witnesses: Mr. Charles P. Melcher, Mr. Steven R. Weafer, Mr. Thomas Hardwick, Mr. Steven C. Carver, Mr. Joseph A. Herz and Mr. Stephen G. Hill.
