**ORDER APPROVING TARIFF FILINGS**

Issue Date: February 23, 2016

Effective Date: March 10, 2016

On December 16, 2015, the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) granted Missouri-American Water Company (“MAWC”) a certificate of convenience and necessity to install, own, acquire, construct, operate, control, manage and maintain a water system in St. Charles County, Missouri, subject to certain conditions. One of the conditions required MAWC to submit new tariff sheets for water service. On February 9, 2016, MAWC filed tariff sheets bearing an effective date of March 10, 2016 in compliance with the Commission’s order.

On February 17, 2016, the Commission’s Staff filed a recommendation that the Commission approve the compliance tariff sheets. The Commission set a deadline for other parties to respond to the Staff recommendation, but no other party has responded within the time set by the Commission. The Commission has reviewed the tariff filings and Staff's verified recommendation and finds that the tariff sheets should be approved.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Missouri-American Water Company's tariff sheets, Tariff Tracking Number YW-2016-0200, are approved to become effective on March 10, 2016. The tariff sheets approved are:
