Such appearances constitute the practice of law,<sup>2</sup> which is subject to the exclusive governance of the Missouri Supreme Court,<sup>3</sup> and which the Commission polices<sup>4</sup> through its regulation 4 CSR 240-2.040(3)(C). That regulation tracks Missouri Supreme Court Rule 9.03. The motion meets the requirements of the rule and the regulation. Also, the motion shows compliance with Missouri Supreme Court Rule 6.01(m), which relates to the required admission fee.

Therefore, the Commission will grant the motion.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The *Motion for Admission Pro Hac Vice* is granted.
2. John P. Coyle is granted leave to appear pro hac vice.
