SUBJECT: Updating Sewer Tariffs

This letter is to inform you of the changes that need to be made in your sewer tariff so that it will be in compliance with current rules and standards set forth by the Missouri Public Service Commission.

The paragraphs that have been checked are the ones that the staff has found that do not meet our requirements. If, after reading this letter, you know of any changes that need to be made but were overlooked by us, please include them in your updated tariff sheets.

1. Discontinuance--"Each utility shall specify the conditions under which it may discontinue service to a customer. Each utility shall include in its rules and regulations that prior to physical discontinuance of service, the utility will mail at least 30 days written notice to the customers by Certified Mail Return Receipt Requested and a copy of said written notice will be forwarded to this commission."

2. Advance Payments & Deposits--"If a utility requires advance payments for sewer service, it will not be permitted to require the customer to make a deposit to insure payment of bills. If the utility does not require advance payments for sewer service, it may require from any customer at any time a cash deposit, provided that the amount of any such deposit so required shall not exceed the amount due for service for one billing period plus 30 days. Interest at the rate of six percent per annum covering the period of the deposit shall be paid by the utility to the customer."

3. The "tariff schedule" shall include: schedules showing all rates and charges and all maps of the area served or professed to be served and the legal description thereof.

* 4. "Each sewer utility shall file with the commission a sample of each type of customer bill form used by the utility."

5. "Each sewer utility shall include in its tariff schedule a statement of the practices and policies of the utility governing extension of its collecting system to provide service to prospective customers."

6. "Each utility shall specify the conditions under which it may refuse to provide service to an applicant."


7. "The utility shall physically inspect all service sewer connections to its system. The applicant for service shall provide adequate advance notice to the utility to facilitate such inspection."

8. "Each sewer utility shall also have on file rules and regulations applicable to the right of access to the customer's premises.

To further your understanding of the requirements outlined in the above paragraphs, please refer to the enclosed copy of Chapter 60--Standards of Service by Sewer Utilities and use it as a model for updating your sewer tariff. Your cooperation in updating your tariff within the next four weeks will be appreciated.

When you submit your revised tariff sheets, please mail them so that we receive them 30 days prior to their effective date. That will give us sufficient time to check them and approve them before they are in effect. If you have any problems in updating your tariff, please feel free to write or telephone me for assistance. 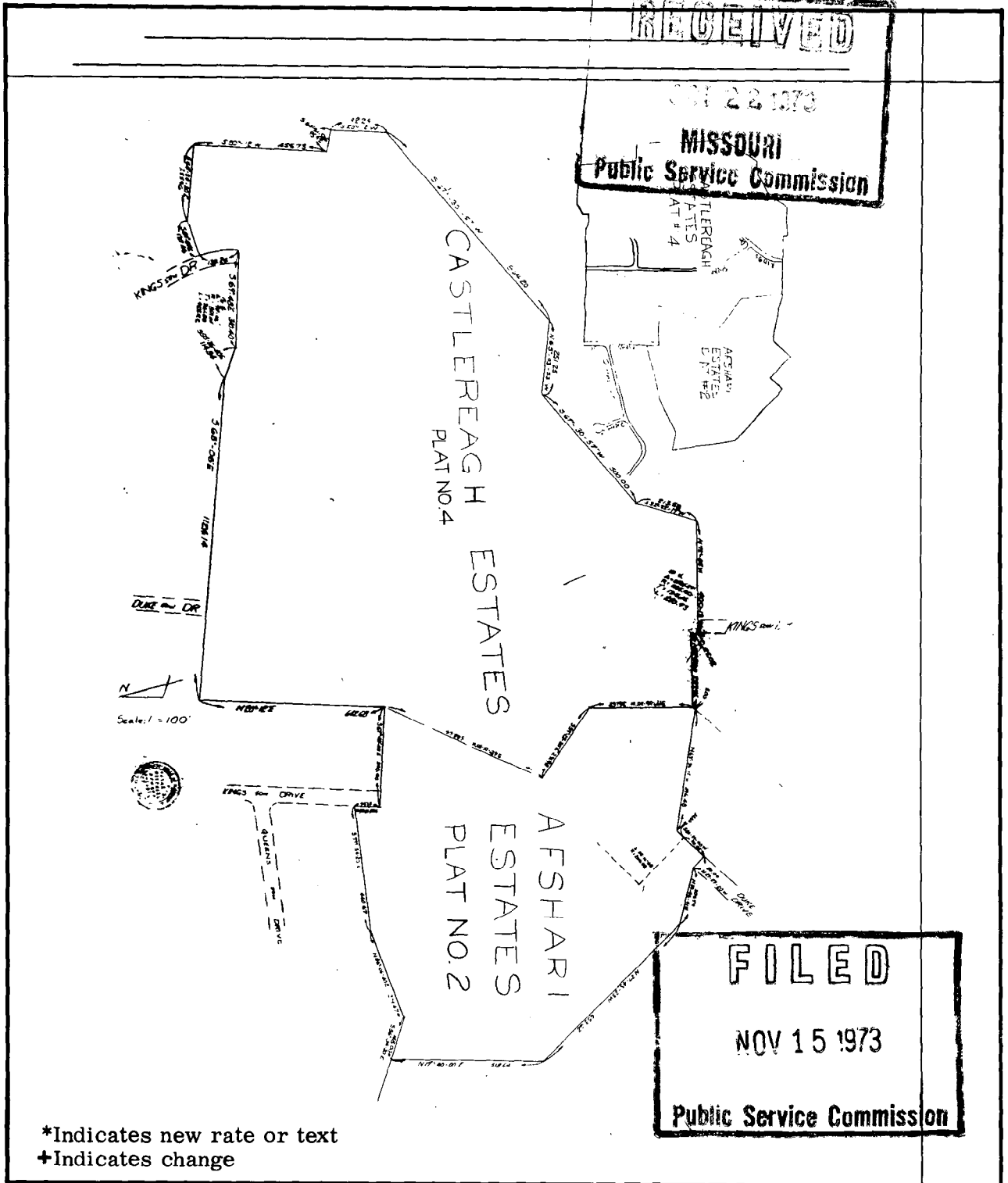

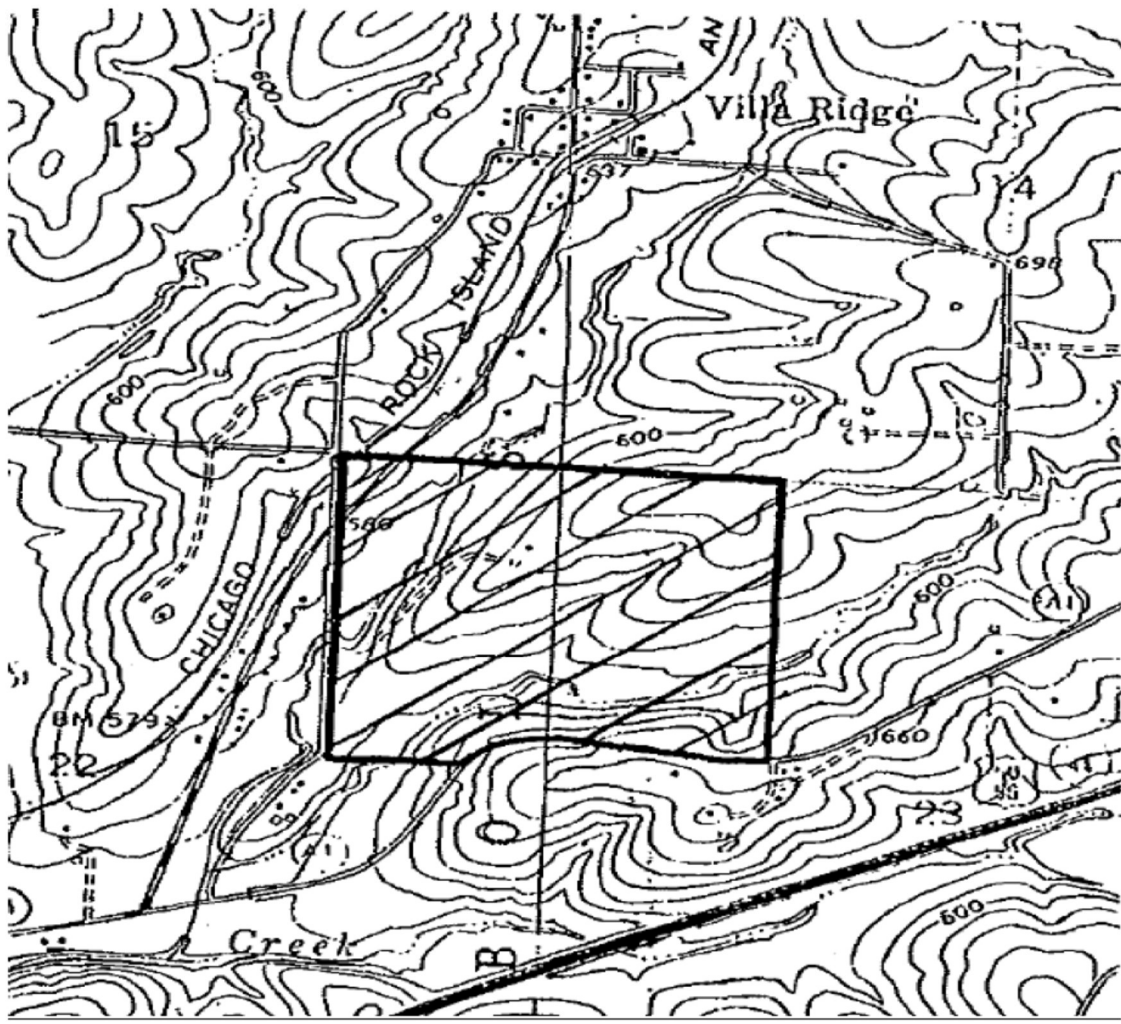

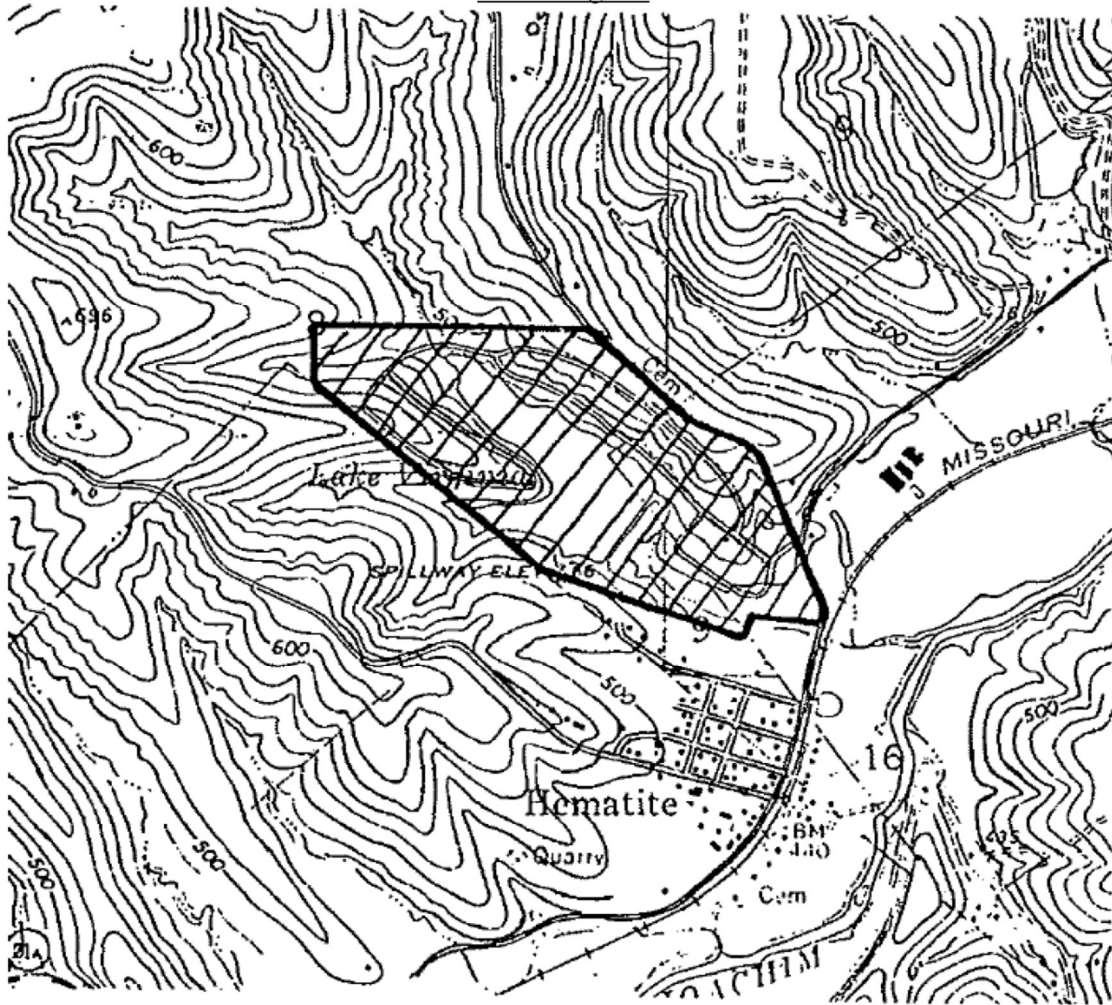

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Rule 4 BILLS AND PAYMENT FOR SEWER SERVICE

(a) Customers are liable for payment for all sewer service to the premises until notice has been received at the Company's office that the use of the sewer is no longer desired. Any Customer terminating service on or before the last day of the month shall be liable for the monthly payment for the number of days of such month prior to the time notice is received to terminate service, prorated on the basis of 30 days to the month.

(b) Bills for sewer services will be mailed or delivered to the Customer's last address as shown by the records of the Company, but failure to receive a bill will not relieve the Customer from the obligation to pay the same. All bills and other accounts must be paid at the office of the Company or other place designated by the Company. All bills for sewer service become delinquent after the due date stated on the bill and service may be discontinued after thirty (30) days' written notice by the Company that the bill is delinquent unless the bill is paid according to said notice. Said notice to be made by certified mail, return receipt requested, with a copy of said notice to the Missouri Public Service Commission.

(c) Any Customer connecting to Company's collecting sewers on or before the last day of the month shall be liable for the monthly sewer service charge for the number of days of service in that month, prorated on the basis of 30 days to the month.

(d) The Company shall have the right to render bills semi-annually, and such bills shall be due and payable on the due date indicated on the bill.

(e) The size and slope of the Customer's service sewer shall be subject to the approval of the Company, but in no event shall the diameter be less than six (6) inches for a single family residence. The slope of such six (6) inch pipe shall not be less than one-eighth (1/8) inch per foot.

(f) Whenever possible the Customer's service sewer shall be brought to the building at an elevation below the basement floor. No building sewer shall be laid parallel to or within three (3) feet of any bearing wall. The depth shall be sufficient to afford protection from frost. The Customer's service sewer shall be laid at a uniform grade and in straight alignment insofar as possible. Changes in direction shall be made only with properly curved pipes and fittings.

(g) In all buildings in which any building drain is too low to permit gravity flow to the Company's collecting sewer, sanitary sewage carried by such drains shall be lifted by approved artificial means and discharged to the Customer's service sewer. No water operated sewage ejector shall be used.

(h) All excavations required for the installation of a Customer's service sewer shall be open trench work unless otherwise approved by the Company. Pipe laying and backfill shall be performed in accordance with ASTM specifications except that no backfill shall be placed until the work has been inspected by the Company. Only those jointing materials and methods which are approved by the Company may be used.

(a) The following requirements for the use of the sanitary sewer system shall be observed. Violation of these requirements will result in the discontinuance of service to the Customer.

(b) No person shall discharge or cause to be discharged, any storm water, surface water, ground water, roof runoff, sub-surface drainage, cooling water or unpolluted industrial process waters to any Company's collecting sewers.

(c) No person shall discharge or cause to be discharged any abnormal or unusual waters or wastes into the Company's collecting sewers.

(d) Grease, oil, and sand interceptors shall be provided and installed by the Customer when, in the opinion of the Company, they are necessary for the proper handling of liquid wastes containing grease in excessive amount, or any flammable wastes, sand, and other harmful ingredients; except that such interceptors shall not be required for private living quarters or dwelling units. All interceptors shall be of a type and capacity approved by the Company and shall be located as to be readily and easily accessible for cleaning and inspection.

(e) Where installed, all grease, oil and sand interceptors shall be maintained by the Customer, at his expense, in continuously efficient operation at all times.

(f) Where preliminary treatment facilities are provided for any waters or wastes, they shall be maintained continuously in satisfactory and effective operation, by the Customer at his expense.

(g) When required by the Company, the Customer service sewer carrying industrial wastes shall include a control manhole in the Customer service sewer to facilitate observation, sampling, and measurement of the wastes. Such manhole, when required, shall be accessibly and safely located, and shall be constructed in accordance with plans approved by the Company. The manhole shall be installed by the Customer at his expense, and shall be maintained by him so as to be safe and accessible at all times.

(h) All measurements, tests, and analyses of the characteristics of waters and wastes to which reference is made in Rule 9, Paragraph (c) shall be determined in accordance with "Standard Methods of Analyses for Water, Sewage and Industrial Wastes" as published by the American Public Health Association and shall be determined at the control manhole provided for in Rule 9, Paragraph (g); or upon suitable samples taken at said control manhole. In the event that no special manhole has been required, the control manhole shall be considered to be the nearest downstream manhole in the Company collecting sewer to the point at which the Customer service sewer is connected.

(a) Service Charges:

1. An application for a service connection of an existing service will be made during the Company's regular business hours.

2. In the event service to any Customer has been discontinued for any reason set forth in Rule 5, and a reconnect charge is provided for, such charge shall be based on cost thereby incurred by the Company.

3. Company personnel will not work upon water piping or facilities not owned by the Company.

4. The service charges cited in the various sections of this Rule are "net" and do not include any applicable Municipal, State or Federal taxes computed on the Company's collections of such charges. Any such taxes will be added in collection or billing service charges, as appropriate.

(b) Customer Deposit:

The Company shall have the right at any time to require the Customer to make a reasonable deposit, an amount not to exceed the bill for one billing period plus thirty (30) days, in advance, to secure the prompt payment of bills. Interest at the rate of six percent (6%), per annum, payable upon return of the deposit, will be paid for the time such deposit was held by the Company unless such period of time be less than twelve (12) months. Such deposits, and any interest earned thereon, shall be refunded at the termination of said service after all charges that may be due and payable to the Customer have been paid, or the Company may apply such deposit and earned interest, to Customer's account. The Company shall issue to every Customer to whom a deposit is received, a non-assignable receipt.

(d) Extensions made under this rule shall be and remain the property of the Company in consideration of its perpetual upkeep and maintenance. The Company also reserves the right to extend further its collecting sewers on intersecting streets.

(e) In any area or subdivision in which the Company's collecting sewer lines have been extended where over thirty percent (30%) of the property owners request service sewer, Company shall extend its sewer lines into such area or subdivision from its collecting sewer line at the cost of the Customer, to be determined as follows:

1. Company shall estimate the cost of extending its sewer lines to such area or subdivision and divide by the number of lots or potential customers, whichever is greater, in such area or subdivision to determine the unit cost to be paid by each customer.

(f) Each Customer shall enter into a contract or agreement with Company to pay the unit cost so determined; provided, however, unless such contract or agreement is entered into prior to the effective date hereof, each Customer entering into a contract or agreement for service sewer after such date shall also be required to enter into a contract or agreement with Company to pay a connection fee of ONE HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$150.00) per single family dwelling.

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
