On June 29, 2015 Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed an application with the Commission requesting a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to operate solar generation facilities in Montgomery County, Missouri. The Commission issued an order setting a July 28 deadline for the filing of applications to intervene. On July 27, the Missouri Solar Energy Industries Association ("MOSEIA") filed an application to intervene.

The Commission will set a deadline for the filing of objections to MOSEIA's application.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Objections to MOSEIA's application to intervene shall be filed no later than August 3, 2015.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
