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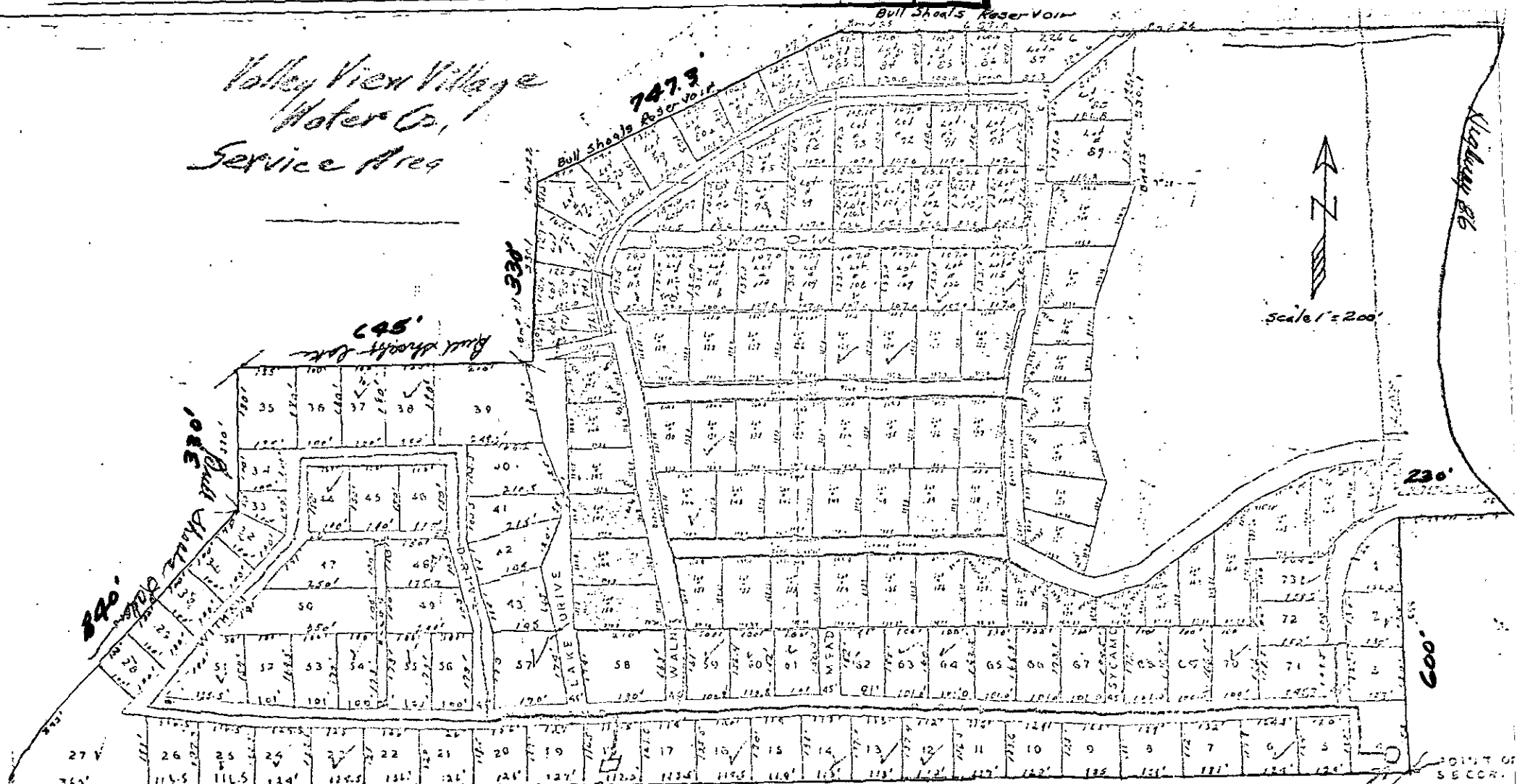

RULES AND REGULATIONS

RULE 1. APPLICATION FOR SERVICE:

Every Customer, before obtaining service, shall execute written application or contract, upon the Company's standard form providing for service at the rates then in force and effective in the locality where service is to be rendered, and shall be governed by the current Rules and Regulations of the Company on file with the Missouri Public Service Commission. An application for service when made by the Customer and accepted by the Company shall constitute a contract. A "Customer" as used herein shall be understood to mean an individual, or corporation, at a single address or location, receiving one class of service.

RULE 2. APPLICATION FOR SERVICE AT DIFFERENT LOCATIONS:

A single application for service cannot be made to apply to different locations nor to cover more than one meter or type of service at the same address or location, to be used by the same Customer. However, in special cases where it is impractical to install only one meter, it shall not be necessary, at the option of the Company furnishing water service, for the Customer to make more than one application for service for his entire installation.

RULE 3. APPLICATION MUST BE IN NAME OF CUSTOMER:

All applications for service shall be made in the true name of the person desiring the service. In case of any violation of this provision, the Company may discontinue service to such Customer at once.

RULE 4. CONDITIONS FOR CONTRACTS:

No promises, agreements or representations of any solicitor or any other employee of the Company shall be binding upon the Company unless the same shall be incorporated in the contract and agreement in writing before the same is signed and accepted.

All contracts for service under the scheduled rates of this Company, except those which make a definite exception, are for yearly periods. The Company may require a contract for a period of more than one year when the customer's requirements for water are unusually large or necessitate considerable special or reserve equipment.

RULE 5. PERMITS AND EASEMENTS:

The applicant must furnish all permits and easements required to enable the Company to supply service except permits for public space.

RULE 6. SUPPLYING WATER SERVICE:

All water service shall be supplied exclusively by the Company while the contract and agreement remain in force.

RULE 7. DELIVERY OF SERVICE:

The point of delivery of water service furnished by the Company shall be at the property line of the property to be served.

All meter installations are to be made by the Company. The cost to the customer for bringing the water to the property line, the installation of a 5/8 inch meter with meter box and cover or the installation of a remote reader shall be \$175.00 and shall be payable with the application for service, in addition to customer contribution in-aid-of-construction under Rule No. 22, if applicable.

The customer's service line from the water main to the customer's property line will be constructed, owned and maintained by the Company. Said service line from the main to the customer's property line shall be constructed of copper pipe having an inside diameter of at least 3/4 of an inch or plastic pipe with a minimum rating of 160 psi having an inside diameter of at least 3/4 of an inch, and a curb cock, box, and meter will be installed by the Company at the property line. The customer's service line from the property line into the customer's buildings will be constructed, owned and maintained by the customer, and this portion of the service line will also be constructed of copper pipe having an inside diameter of at least 3/4 of an inch or plastic pipe with a minimum rating of 125 psi having an inside diameter of at least 3/4 of an inch. Customer shall be responsible for the cost of repairing any damage to the Company's lines, meters, meter box, meter box cover or remote reader caused by the Customer or his agent.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Separate premises must have separate service pipes, curb cocks and boxes and meters.

No person or persons except an authorized employee of the Company will be permitted to make taps in the distribution mains. No one other than the employees of the Company shall turn water on to any premises either in the first instance or after the water has been turned off.

**RULE 8. EXTRA WORK FOR LOCATION OF METER:**

Should it be necessary for any reason to place the meter at any other location than at the point of delivery defined under Rule 7, the work of constructing the intermediate service lines shall be done by the Customer at his expense, provided that when the condition making the extra work necessary is beyond the control of the Customer, the additional expense shall be borne by the Company.

**RULE 9. PAYMENT RULES:**

All charges for water service are payable either at the Company office or at a designated collection agency, or by mail addressed to the Company.

Bills for service will be rendered by the Company between the first and the fifth day of each month and shall cover the service furnished for the one month period preceding the billing date. Bills shall be due 21 days after the date distributed.

Failure of the customer to receive bill shall not, however, relieve him from the obligation of paying the amount owed by him to the Company. It is the intent that the customer shall call at the Office of the Company for the statement when not receiving the same.

RULE 10. ADJUSTMENT OF METER ERROR:

The customer shall accept the meter installed by the Company as a standard of measurement. Should the meter become defective or fail to register correctly, the quantity used shall be determined by the amount used during a corresponding period of the preceding year, or by an estimate based on the average amount of water used during the preceding twelve months proportioned to the period during which the meter is shown to have been inaccurate.

RULE 11. TESTING OF METERS:

The Company at its own expense, will make periodic tests and inspections of its meters in order to maintain them at a high standard of accuracy. Upon request, the Company will test any water meter, free of charges, provided that the meter in question has not been tested within twelve months previous to such request. If the meter has been tested within said twelve months period and the test reveals the meter to be accurate within a range of 95% to 105%, a charge of \$10.00 will be made.

RULE 12. INSPECTION OF COMPANY'S PROPERTY:

The Company is hereby given the right to enter upon the premises of the Customer at all reasonable times for the purposes of inspecting, testing, repairing, removing or exchanging all equipment or appliances belonging to the Company and used in connection with its service, and removing its property on the termination of the contract and agreement, or the discontinuance of service for any cause whatsoever.

RULE 13. DAMAGE TO COMPANY PROPERTY AND DEFECTIVE SERVICE:

The Company shall keep in repair and maintain its own property on the Customer's premises, provided, however, that if its property is damaged by the Customer or representative of the same, the cost of such repairs shall be paid by the Customer; in case of defective service, written notice of the fact should be sent to the Company's office immediately.

**RULE 14. FAILURE BY COMPANY TO FURNISH SERVICE:**

The Company shall use reasonable diligence in providing a regular and uninterrupted supply of water, but in case the supply of water is interrupted by reason of strike, riot, invasion, storm, fire, accident, breakdown, legal process, state or municipal interference, or any cause beyond its control, the Company shall not be liable for damages to the Customer for interruptions in the service due to any of the aforesaid causes.

**RULE 15. ARREARS:**

All bills for service shall be due and payable within twenty-one (21) days from the date of mailing or delivery thereof and Customers whose bills are not so paid shall be considered in arrears.

**RULE 16. DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE FOR NON-PAYMENT OF BILLS:**

After giving a domestic water Customer five (5) days' written notice and any other Customer forty-eight (48) hours' written notice by first class mail that he is in arrears in the payment of bills rendered by the Company for service or has failed to comply with the terms of the contract, agreement, or these Rules and Regulations contained herein, the Company may discontinue all service supplied to such Customer. In case the Company discontinues its service for any of these causes or is, through the fault of the Customer, prevented from supplying water according to the provisions of the contract and agreement, then there shall forthwith become due and payable to the Company as liquidated damages, and not as a penalty, the amount remaining unpaid, and also the amount which is guaranteed by the contract and agreement as a minimum payment for the same. Also, in case the Company discontinues its water service for any of these causes, it shall require a charge of ten dollars (\$10.00) for cost of each reconnection before water is again supplied to the Customer.

Temporary turn off and on at curb stop, for the customer's repairing convenience may be subject to a service charge not to exceed ten dollars (\$10.00).

**RULE 17. FRAUDULENT USE OF WATER SERVICE:**

In the event fraudulent use of water is discovered, the Company shall have the right to discontinue service without notice to the Customer, and service will not be resumed to the Customer until Customer shall have paid all bills, including the water fraudulently consumed, paid all damages to the meter, if any, and complied with the installation specifications that may be required by the Company.

The Customer will be notified of such discontinuance immediately, with a statement concerning the reason for discontinuance.

**RULE 18. DELINQUENT BILLS:**

The Company reserves the right to refuse to render service to a Customer at any new address until all delinquent bills of such Customer for water service accruing within five (5) years prior to such application are paid.

**RULE 19. DEPOSIT FROM CUSTOMER TO GUARANTEE PAYMENT:**

The Company may require from any Customer, or prospective Customer, a deposit intended to guarantee payment of water bills. Such deposit shall not exceed the amount for one billing period plus 30 days for such Customer. Interest thereon of six (6) percent shall be paid to said Customer annually, and when service is discontinued and the Customer makes application for the return of his deposit, Company shall pay said interest on said deposit for the period since the last annual interest payment that such deposit is held by the Company and the Customer is served, provided such period is not less than six months.

**RULE 20. MORE THAN ONE POINT OF DELIVERY:**

Where service is rendered at more than one point of delivery or for more than one class of service except where necessitated by the Company's facilities, each shall be billed separately.

RULE 21. MORE THAN ONE CUSTOMER:

In case service is rendered at one point of delivery to more than one individual Customer, or to more than one location, address, establishment, or interconnected structure, the size of each rate block preceding the final block of the applicable rate schedule shall be multiplied by the number of above-described premises so served.

RULE 22. EXTENSION OF MAINS:

Every customer whose service will be connected to a water main extended under the provisions of this rule shall tender to the Company a contribution-in-aid-of-construction equal to pro-rata share of the cost of such extension as is determined under the provisions of this rule, or based on one-half of the per foot cost of the extension multiplied by the front footage owned by the applicant-customer.

A. This rule shall govern the extension of mains by the Company in areas where there are no water mains in the streets and/or roadways. The Company will extend its mains along streets or roads within its certificated area to serve new customers under the following terms and conditions:

1. Upon receipt of written application(s) as required in Rule 1, the Company will provide the applicant(s) with an estimate of the cost of the proposed extension. Said estimate shall include all labor and materials required, including valves, fire hydrants, booster stations, storage facilities, reconstruction of existing mains if necessary, supervision, engineering, permits, insurance, tool expense, accounting and related expenses, and all other costs incident to the installation of said extension.
2. Applicant(s) shall enter into a contract with the Company for the installation of said extension and shall tender to the Company a contribution-in-aid-of-construction equal to the amount determined in A-1, plus the appropriate customer connection fee. Applicant(s) shall have the option of installing the main extension under the provisions of Rule 22-B in lieu of entering into said contract.

3. Refunds of contributions shall be made to applicant(s) as follows:
  - (a) Should the actual cost of extension be less than the estimated cost, the Company shall refund the difference as soon as the actual cost has been ascertained.
  - (b) Company shall divide the actual cost of the extension by the number of lots abutting said extension to determine the per lot extension cost. When counting lots, corner lots which abut an existing main shall be excluded. As additional customers are directly attached to the extension during the first ten years after the installation is made, they shall pay to the Company the per lot extension cost for each lot being connected, which the company will refund to the applicant(s) who initially contracted for the extension.
  - (c) Each refund shall be distributed to initial applicant(s) based upon the percentage of the actual extension cost contributed by each applicant.
4. Extensions made under this rule shall be and remain the property of the Company in consideration of its perpetual upkeep and maintenance.
5. The Company reserves the right to further extend the main and to connect lateral mains from extensions made hereunder, and the attaching of customers to such further extensions shall not entitle applicant(s) contracting for the original extension to additional refund.
6. The pipe used in making extensions under this rule shall be of a type and size which will be reasonably adequate to supply the area to be served. Such determination as to size and type of pipe shall be left solely to the judgment of the Company. If the Company desires to, make

7. Refunds shall be made to original applicant(s) as follows:

- (a) Company shall divide the actual cost of the extension by the number of lots abutting said extension to obtain the per lot extension cost. When counting lots, corner lots which abut an existing main shall be excluded. As additional customers are directly attached to the extension during the first ten years after the installation is made, they shall pay to the Company the per lot extension cost for each lot being connected which the Company will refund to the applicant(s) who initially contracted for the extension.
- (b) Each payment shall be distributed to the initial applicant(s) based upon the percentage of the actual extension cost contributed by each applicant.

8. Extensions made under this rule shall be contributed to the Company in consideration of its perpetual upkeep and maintenance.

9. The Company reserves the right to further extend the main and to connect lateral mains from extensions made hereunder, and the attaching of customers to such further extension shall not entitle applicant(s) contributing the extension to the Company to additional payments.

RULE 23. ALTERATIONS TO RULES AND REGULATIONS:

The Company reserves the right at any time to alter or amend, or add to its Rules and Regulations, or to substitute other Rules and Regulations therefor, subject to the approval of the Public Service Commission of the State of Missouri.
