In lieu of a DAL, Teleconnect may allow a customer to provide a standard RJ31X jack used in conjunction with nonregulated Teleconnect terminal equipment on a line or trunk utilized for outbound SUPERWATS messages only. If the DAL or RJ31X jack is provided other than by Teleconnect, Teleconnect will not make any adjustments for service problems that it reasonably assumes originate with the DAL or jack.
