Rules and Regulations

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GENERAL:

Rules applicable other than those set out in this schedule will be in conformance with those prescribed by Missouri Public Service Commission in its general order #20.

1. Applications

(a) Parties desiring water service shall be required to make application in writing for same, and the applicant shall agree in said written application, that he or she will purchase water from the company in accordance with this published rate for a minimum period of 3 years following the date of said application.

2. Deposits

No deposits will be required.

3. After giving a water consumer five days written notice that he is in arrears in the payment rendered by the Company for service, or that he has failed to comply with the terms of the contract, agreement, or the rules and regulations contained herein, the Company may discontinue all service supplied to such consumer. Said written notice may be given by United States mail, or by delivery of said notice to the consumer, or to some member of his household over the age of fifteen years on the premises served, or by delivery to the servant or employee of the owner or lessee of the premises served, in case said premises consist of commercial or business establishments. In case the Company discontinues its water service of any of these causes, it shall require a charge of Two Dollars (\$2.00) for the cost of each reconnection before water is again supplied to the consumer. A temporary turn-off at the curb stop for consumers convenience in case of making repairs, shall be subject to a service charge not to exceed Two Dollars (\$2.00). This is to include both turning off and reconnecting.

4. Service will be rendered on a metered basis; that is, water will be charged for upon the basis of amount of water used, in accordance with the price schedule set forth in this tariff.

5. All customers shall prevent unnecessary waste of water by keeping their faucets, valves and other appurtenances in good repair and accessible at all reasonable times for the inspection of the company's employees.

6. Employees or agents of the Company shall have access at all reasonable hours to the premises supplied for the purpose of making necessary examination of plumbing and other appurtenances pertaining to the water system.

7. The point of delivery of water by the Company will be at the property line of the customer. **MISSOURI Public Service Commission**

8. The customer service line, from the water main, to the customer's property line will be constructed, owned and maintained by the company. Said service line from the main to the customer's property line shall be constructed of copper pipe, having an inside diameter of at least 1 inch, and a curb cock and box will be installed by the Company at or near the property line. The customer's service line from the property line into the Customer's buildings will be constructed, owned and maintained by the Customer and this portion of the service line will also be constructed of copper pipe having an inside diameter of at least 3/4 inch.

9. Ea-h water service line, applicable above, must be placed in a trench separate from any other utility services.

10. Separate premises must have separate curb cocks and curb boxes.

11. The Company shall use reasonable diligence in providing a regular and uninterrupted supply of water, but in case the supply of water is interrupted by reason of strike, riot, invasion, storm, fire, accident, break down, legal process, state or municipal interference, or any other cause beyond its control, the Company shall not be liable for damages to the Customer for interruption in service, due to any of the aforesaid causes.

12. The Manager of the Water Company shall be authorized to regulate or limit any unusual, unnecessary or wasteful use of water, where such use of water may effect service to other customers and to restrict or regulate the quantity of water used by customers in case of scarcity or whenever in his judgment an emergency effecting Public Health and Welfare may require such restrictions. **FILED DEC 6 1969 Public Service Commission**

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Rules and Regulations (Continued)

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13 DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE OF CUSTOMER premises are to be vacated or there is a change of owner, or occupant or agent, prompt notice must be given to the Company. Service may be discontinued by the customer by giving not less than Forty-Eight (48) hours notice to the Company during its regular office hours. Final bills for service shall become due and payable at once.

14. The Company reserves the right at any time to alter or amend, or add to its Rules and Regulations, or to substitute other Rules and Regulations therefor, subject to the approval of the Public Service Commission of the State of Missouri.

15. The Company will extend, own and maintain all water mains and will also maintain the service line leading from the main to the property line of the consumer; service lines from the property line of the consumer onto consumer's premises shall be installed and maintained by the consumer. The service line from the main to the property line will be construed as the property of the Company.

16. The Company will extend its water mains within its service area so as to provide a water main located in the street abutting each lot throughout the service area, at the expense of the Company as said service is demanded.

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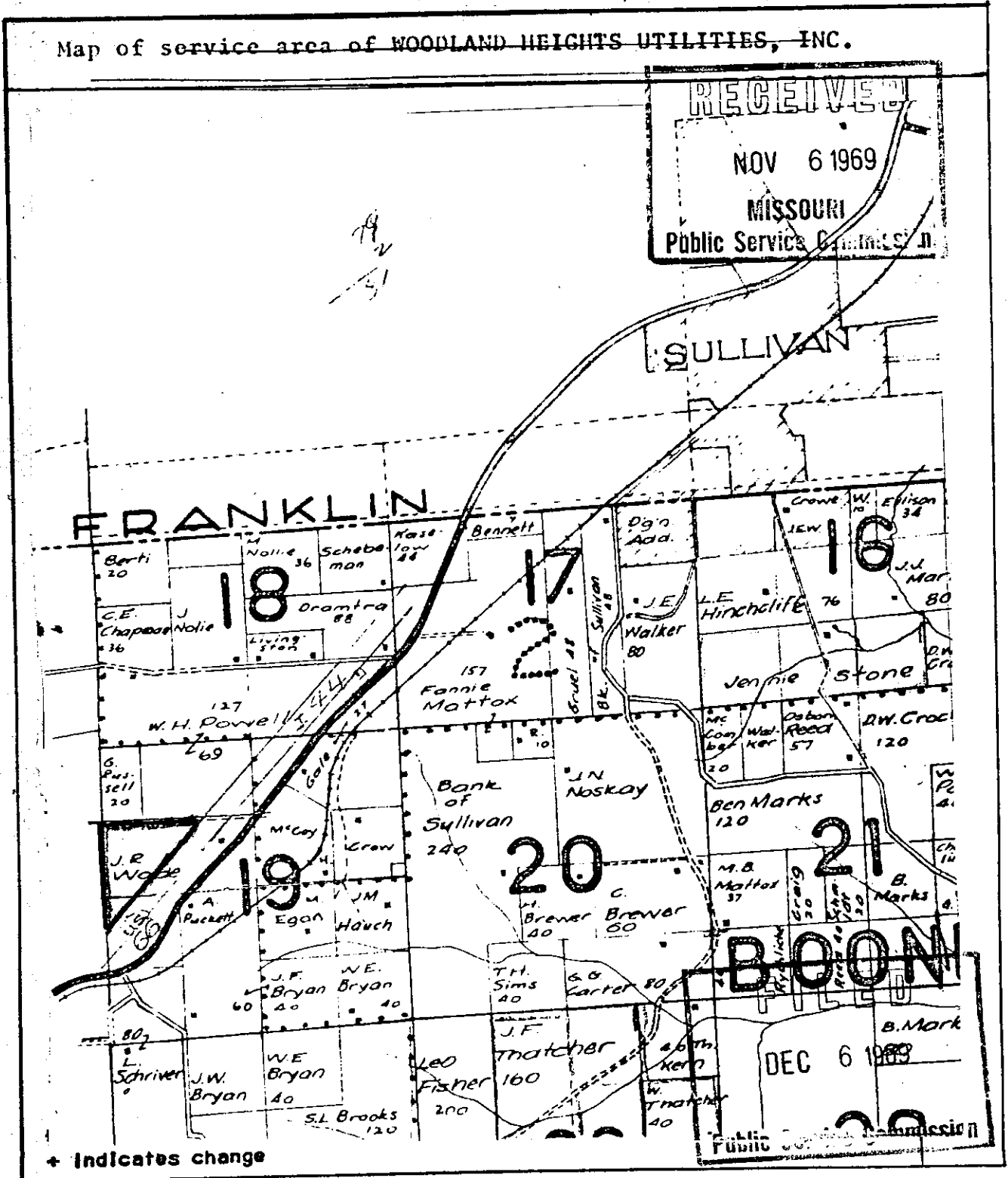
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Map of service area of WOODLAND HEIGHTS UTILITIES, INC.

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
