B. INSIDE MOVE CHARGES

- 1. An inside move is a transfer of telephone service or equipment from one location to another on the same premises where there is $lac{1}{2}$ no interruption of the service other than is incident to the work involved.
 - (a) An inside move may be made in either of two ways, the circumstances in each case determining the procedure to be followed.
 - By an actual change in location of the equipment from the old to the new location.
 - (2) By the installation of equipment at the new location and the subsequent disconnection and removal of the equipment at the old location. In such cases where a switchboard or dial branch exchange system is involved, the cost of the move includes the cost of installing equipment at the new location equal in capacity to that at the old location, the cost of removal of the equipment at the old location, and the cost of rearrangement of extensions of wiring.
 - 2. Discontinuance of telephone service and equipment at one premises and their installation at another premises is not considered an "Inside move" and is provided for subject to the regular termination charges, and service connection charges and/or any installation charges that may be applicable

A. General Regulations

The Link Up Missouri Service Connection Program is a Federal Lifeline assistance program applicable to eligible residential subscribers, as defined below, and designed to promote ILC SERVICE COMP subscribership to the telephone network among low income residential households.

- 1. Service Connection Charges, as set forth in this tariff*, for initial installation of the main residential service access line, will be discounted at a rate of 50 percent, or \$30.00, whichever is less. These reduced charges shall be assessed only for a single residential telephone line per eligible household at the principle place of residence.
- 2. The customer may defer payment on up to \$200 of the above charges without interest for a period not to exceed one year. The deferred charges do not include any permissible security deposits required. Payments shall be equally paid over a twelve month period.
- 3. A qualifying low-income customer may choose with 1 or 2, or both 1 and 2 as described above.
- Link Up assistance is available for a second or subsequent time only for a principal place of
 residence with an address different from the residence address where assistance was previously
 provided.
- 5. The premises at which the residence service is requested must be the applicant's principal place of residence.
- 6. There is only one telephone line serving the residence premises. The residence premises household (dwelling unit) shall consist of that portion of an individual house or building or one flat or apartment occupied by a single family or individuals functioning as one domestic establishment.
- 7. Link Up will not be furnished on a Foreign Exchange service.
