ORDER APPROVING FUEL ADJUSTMENT TRUE-UP AND APPROVING TARIFF TO CHANGE FUEL ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE RATES

Effective Date: March 1, 2018

In each of these files, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (“GMO”) filed a tariff and supporting testimony. Staff filed a recommendation in favor of the tariff. The Commission received no application for intervention.

In File No. ER-2018-0081, GMO seeks the Commission’s approval of true-up amounts related to the company’s fuel adjustment clause (“FAC”), which passes increases or decreases in net fuel costs to customers without a general rate case. These amounts relate to the company’s Recovery Period 18 (December 1, 2015 through May 31, 2016). For that period, GMO alleges a true-up amount of \$546,583 in over-recovery. That amount is a component of the FAC for Accumulation Period 21 (June 1, 2017, through November 30, 2017), which is the subject of File No. ER-2018-0180. In that case, GMO asks to

increase its rates per kilowatt hour (“kWh”) by \$0.00080. For a residential customer using 1,000 kWh per month, the tariff increases the FAC by approximately \$0.80 per month.

On the basis of the verified and uncontested filings, the Commission concludes that the tariff conforms to the applicable statutes, regulations, and tariffs. Thus, the Commission will approve the tariff.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The tariff assigned Tracking No. JE-2018-0080 is approved to become effective on March 1, 2018.


