**ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE
AND NECESSITY AND CANCELING ASSOCIATED TARIFF**

On July 12, 2010,¹ RDG Development, LLC ("RDG"), filed an application. That application requested, among other things, authority from the Commission for RDG to sell its sewer system to Greenwood Hills Homeowners Association. RDG and Greenwood Hills entered into an agreement on June 22, in which Greenwood Hills agreed to purchase RDG's sewer system.

The Commission received no intervention requests, and Staff recommended the Commission approve the transaction. On October 20, the Commission approved the application.

As required in the Commission's October 20 order, on November 5, RDG notified the Commission that the transfer was complete. Because RDG no longer provides sewer service, and because Staff recommended the Commission cancel RDG's certificate and tariff upon completion of the transfer, the Commission will do so at this time.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to provide sewer service granted to RDG Development, LLC in Case No. SA-2010-0096 is canceled.
2. The tariff allowing RDG Development to provide sewer service, denominated Tariff No. YS-2010-0397, is canceled.
3. This order shall become effective on November 27, 2010.
4. This case shall be closed on November 28, 2010.
