**ORDER APPROVING FUEL ADJUSTMENT TRUE-UP AND APPROVING
TARIFF TO CHANGE FUEL ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE RATES**

Issue Date: March 21, 2018

Effective Date: April 1, 2018

Kansas City Power & Light Company (“the company”) filed an application¹ seeking the Commission’s approval of true-up amounts related to the company’s fuel adjustment clause (“FAC”).² Based in part on those amounts, the company also filed a tariff³ to adjust the company’s fuel adjustment rates (“FARs”), which determine the company’s fuel adjustment clause (“FAC”).

The application relates to the company’s Recovery Period 2 (October 1, 2016 through September 30, 2017). For that period, the company alleges a true-up amount of \$1,574,675 in under-recovery exclusive of interest. Based in part on those amounts, the

tariff addresses the company’s Accumulation Period 5 (July 1, 2017, through December 31, 2017) as follows.

<i>Current Annual FAR per kWh</i>			
<i>Service</i>	<i>Proposed</i>	<i>Now Effective</i>	<i>Difference</i>
Primary	\$0.00484	\$0.00665	\$0.00181 Decrease
Secondary (Residential Service)	\$0.00495	\$0.00682	\$0.00187 Decrease
Transmission/Substation	\$0.00472	\$0.00659	\$0.00187 Decrease

The tariff decreases the bill of a typical residential customer—one using 1,000 kWh per month—by approximately \$1.87 per month.

The company filed information supporting the tariff⁴ and testimony supporting the application and the tariff⁵ and Staff filed recommendations in favor of granting the application⁶ and approving the tariff.⁷ The Commission received no other filings.⁸ No hearing is necessary to grant unopposed relief,⁹ so neither of these actions is a contested case,¹⁰ and the Commission need not separately state its findings of fact. On the basis of the verified and uncontested filings, the Commission will grant the application and approve the tariff.
