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Intrastate Switched Access Tariff

1.1 Application of Tariff

This Intrastate Switched Access Service Tariff (the "Tariff") contains regulations, rates and charges applicable to the provisions of intrastate switched access service provided by Mercury Voice and Data Company (the "Company"), a competitive facilities-based provider of telecommunications services, to customers in the St. Joseph and Agency exchanges, that wish to purchase switched access from the Company.

Customers may purchase switched access service from the Company only to the extent explicitly set forth in this Tariff.
