4. In the case of one-way service, intercept treatment will be provided (where available).
5. A maximum of one customer-provided instrument-implemented pay telephone may be connected to any one Customer-Owned Pay Telephone Service Access Line.

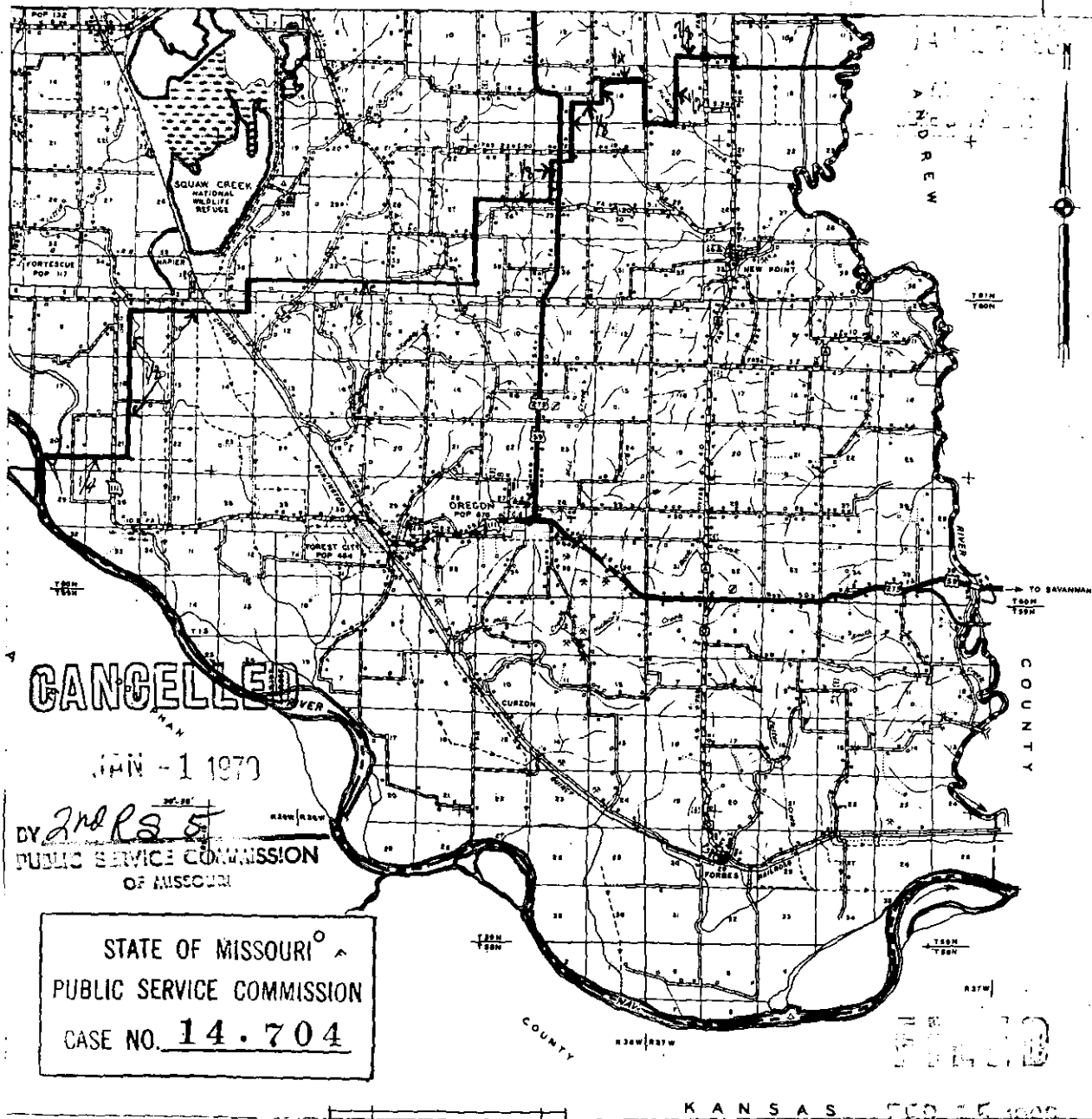

The telephone company is not obligated to furnish service to any individual or firm that has an unpaid and undisputed delinquent account for service previously rendered by the company at the same or different address, until arrangements have been made to liquidate such previous indebtedness to the company.

The Company may require at any time a cash deposit, or at its option, a personal guaranty of a responsible person, from any subscriber. The amount so required shall not exceed the amount of one months bill for local exchange service plus an estimated two months bill for toll service. Any person who alleges such emergency shall if requested provide the telephone company with reasonable evidence of such necessity.
- 8.7 Notwithstanding any other provisions of this tariff, service to a customer may be discontinued at any time after written notice has been sent, certified mail, to such customer at his last known address and at the address where the service to be discontinued is provided such customer.
- A. Incurs charges not covered by a deposit or guarantee and evidences an intent not to pay such charges when due: or
- B. Damages or evidences an intent to damage telephone facilities.
- 8.8 The notice required by section (7) of this rule shall state how a customer has evidenced an intent not to pay charges when due or evidences an intent to damage telephone facilities.
9. Service Connection Charge
These charges are set out in the rate schedules, under miscellaneous tariff. For the purpose of these rules the service connection charge shall be a charge to the customer for connecting service after it has been suspended for nonpayment of proper charges for service and has not been removed from the premises. All other connection of service shall be classified as an installation charge.
10. Profane Language
Profane and obscene language over the telephone is prohibited. The subscriber is responsible for the enforcement of this rule. Failure to observe this rule will constitute cause for disconnecting service.

15 - ENTERING PREMISES OF SUBSCRIBER -

17 - DISCONTINUANCE -

Upon written notice from any Federal, State or Local law enforcement agency that any telephone or other facility supplied by the Company is being used by any person for the purpose of transmitting or receiving gambling information, the Company will discontinue such service. The company shall give notice to the subscriber at the time of the discontinuance of service of its reasons for doing so, said notice to be accompanied by a copy of the notice from such law enforcement agency.

18 - SERVICE AREA -

Whenever reference is made in the rate schedules and these rules and regulations applying to initial rate area, such area will mean the area within the corporate limits of any municipality in which an exchange may be located, and the area of any adjoining municipality, or in the event an exchange is in an unincorporated area, it shall mean an area as designated upon a plat filed with the schedule. Whenever reference is made to the exchange area, it shall include all of the area within the limits fixed for the respective exchange areas by order of the Missouri Public Service Commission, or on a plat filed with the Commission.
