**ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT
AND APPROVING TARIFF**

Issue Date: April 21, 2021

Effective Date: April 30, 2021

On February 24, 2021,¹ the Commission issued its Order Granting Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (Order) to Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC) to install, own, acquire, construct, operate, control, manage, and maintain a water system in an area of Stone County, Missouri (Table Rock Estates). As a condition of the Order, the Commission required MAWC to submit tariff sheets, to become effective before closing on the assets, to include a service area map and service area written description, to be included in its EFIS water tariff P.S.C. MO No 13 and water rates, applicable specifically to water service in its Table Rock service area.

On April 15, MAWC submitted Tariff Revision, tracking number YW-2021-0184, and advised the Commission that the compliance tariff sheets were being filed pursuant to and in conformity with the Order. The proposed tariff sheets bear an issue date of

April 15 and an effective date of May 15. On April 15, MAWC also filed a Motion for Expedited Treatment advising the Commission that Table Rock Estates was prepared to close on April 30, and asking the Commission to allow the proposed tariff sheets to become effective on less than thirty days' notice, to be effective on April 30. The Commission ordered Staff to file a recommendation no later than April 19 and set that date as a deadline for objections or responses to the proposed tariff sheets. On April 19, Staff recommended approval of the proposed tariff sheets. No other responses or objections were filed. Upon reviewing the pleadings, the Commission finds MAWC's proposed tariff sheets comply with the Commission's February 24 Order and will approve them. No objections have been received to the Motion for Expedited Treatment or to the request that the tariffs become effective on April 30. Because closing on the assets is scheduled for April 30, the Commission finds good cause to make this order effective in fewer than thirty days. To accommodate the asset closing date and MAWC's request, the Commission will grant MAWC's Motion for Expedited Treatment and will approve the tariff sheets to become effective on April 30, 2021.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. MAWC's Motion for Expedited Treatment is granted.
2. The tariff sheets assigned tracking number YW-2021-0184 are approved to become effective on April 30, 2021.
3. This order shall be effective on April 30, 2021.
4. This file may be closed on May 3, 2021.
