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



Access Services

Access Services are those services which are described in the Commission Access Services Tariff of Oregon Farmers Mutual Telephone Company. These services are offered by the Company to intrastate interexchange customers (ICs) in accordance with the rules and regulations specified in the Access Services Tariff of Oregon Farmers Mutual Telephone Company and approved by the Missouri Public Service Commission, and in any amendments thereto and authorized by the Missouri Public Service Commission or applicable law. 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




