These tariff sheets are being issued November 26, 2013 to become effective on and after December 26, 2013.

The Company is requesting that the Commission grant Company's request to modify its Rider SR – Solar Rebate Electric Power Purchases From Qualified Net Metering Units tariffs.

The Company is also requesting a waiver of the Commission's rule 4 CSR 240-20.100 to facilitate establishing a reservation queue whereby the Company may commit solar rebate funding for a specific customer application. This change is necessary to facilitate an orderly market for solar installations by retail customers.

Finally, Company is requesting that the tariffs and rule waiver be granted expedited treatment.

This filing does not constitute completion of all aspects of the stipulation and the parties continue to work together to establish the specific rebate queue information that will be posted on the Company's website.
