**NOTICE THAT SPIRE MISSOURI'S WNAR TARIFF SHEETS WILL BE  
ALLOWED TO GO INTO EFFECT**

On August 30, 2019 Spire Missouri filed tariff sheets to revise its Weather Normalization Adjustment Rider (WNAR). The tariff sheets have an October 1, 2019, effective date. The Commission ordered Staff to file a recommendation regarding the tariff sheets by September 20, 2019. On September 17, 2019, Spire Missouri filed substitute tariff sheets based upon Staff's suggested edits to the company's WNAR tariff sheets. Staff reviewed the WNAR adjustment calculations and filed a recommendation and report recommending Commission approval of the substitute tariff sheets.

Based on Staff's recommendation, the Commission will allow the substitute tariff sheets filed on September 17, 2019, to take effect by operation of law on their October 1, 2019, effective date. The tariff sheets, as substituted, that will take effect are:
