**ORDER APPROVING TARIFF IN COMPLIANCE WITH COMMISSION ORDER**

Issue Date: March 27, 2006

Effective Date: April 5, 2006

On March 9, 2005, Timber Creek Sewer Company filed an application for a certificate of convenience and necessity to construct and operate a sewer system in an unincorporated area of Clay County, Missouri in the Oakbrook subdivision. On January 5, 2006, the Missouri Public Service Commission issued an order granting the requested relief. As part of this order, the company was directed to submit “new and revised tariff sheets for its existing tariff or complete new tariff, including provisions consistent with the above discussions on this matter. . . .”

On March 6, the company submitted a new tariff as directed by the Commission. The Staff of the Commission filed its recommendation on March 24. Staff states that it believes the tariff is in compliance with the Commission’s order and advises the Commission to approve the tariff to become effective on April 5, 2006.

The Commission has reviewed the tariff and finds it to be in compliance with the Commission’s order. The Commission will therefore approve the tariff.
