ORDER APPROVING DEMAND SIDE INVESTMENT MECHANISM RIDER RATE ADJUSTMENT TARIFF

Issue Date: January 16, 2019 Effective Date: February 1, 2019

On November 30, 2018, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (GMO) filed a tariff, with supporting testimony, to adjust charges related to its approved Demand Side Investment Mechanism (DSIM) rider. The submitted tariff sheet carries an effective date of February 1, 2019. The Commission issued notice of the filing, set an intervention deadline, and directed the Commission's Staff to submit a recommendation. Staff submitted its recommendation on December 31, advising the Commission to approve GMO's tariff. No party filed a response to Staff's recommendation.

Commission Rules 4 CSR 240-20.093(4) and 4 CSR 240-3.163(8) require GMO to make semi-annual adjustments of its DSIM rates to reflect the amount of revenue that has been over- or under-collected. The proposed tariff sheet decreases the current residential DSIM Rider rate from \$0.00443 per kWh to \$0.00019 per kWh for residential customers and decreases the DSIM Rider rate from \$0.00348 per kWh to \$0.00258 per kWh for non-

residential customers. GMO's requested adjustment would decrease the bill of a residential customer by \$4.24 for every 1,000 kWhs used. It would decrease a non-residential customer's bill by \$0.90 for every 1,000 kWhs used.

The Commission's rule 4 CSR 240-20.093(4) regarding adjustment of DSIM rates between general rate proceedings states that if the proposed adjustments are in accordance with the rule, Section 393.1075, RSMo, and the previously-approved DSIM, the Commission shall issue an order approving the tariff sheets, and the adjustments shall take effect sixty days after the tariff is filed. The Commission has reviewed GMO's tariff filings and Staff's recommendation and memorandum, and finds that the proposed tariff sheet implementing the DSIM rate adjustment is in compliance with GMO's existing DSIM tariffs and with all applicable statutes and regulations. The Commission will approve GMO's tariff.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company's tariff filing, assigned Tariff Tracking No. JE-2019-0109, is approved to be effective February 1, 2019, as an interim rate adjustment, subject to prudence review. The tariff sheet approved is:
