ORDER GRANTING APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE

On May 21, 2018, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission seeking an order granting a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) pursuant to section 393.170, RSMo 2016. The CCN would authorize Ameren Missouri to construct, own, and operate a wind generation facility to be constructed in Schuyler and Adair Counties in Missouri. Ameren Missouri’s application also seeks approval of a Renewable Energy Standard Cost Recovery Mechanism (RESRAM), and a waiver of certain Commission rules.

The Missouri Department of Economic Development – Division of Energy applied to intervene on May 22. The next day, on May 23, the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers (MIEC), and Renew Missouri Advocates, d/b/a Renew Missouri, filed applications to intervene.

More than ten days have passed since those applications to intervene were filed and no one has responded to the applications.

The Commission finds that allowing the Division of Energy, MIEC, and Renew Missouri to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(3), the Commission will grant the applications to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Missouri Department of Economic Development – Division of Energy’s application to intervene is granted.
2. The Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers’ application to intervene is granted.
3. Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri’s application to intervene is granted.
4. This order shall be effective when issued.
