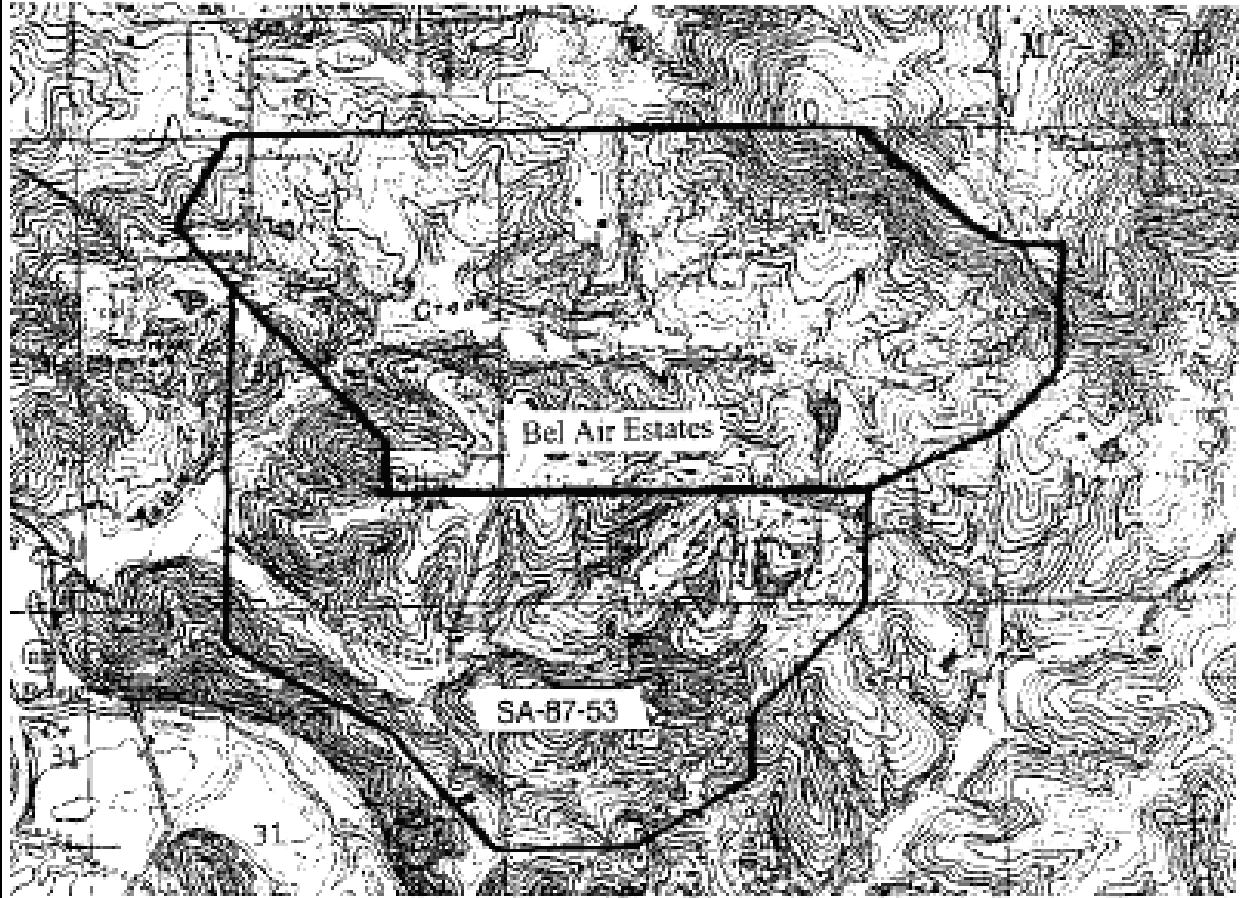

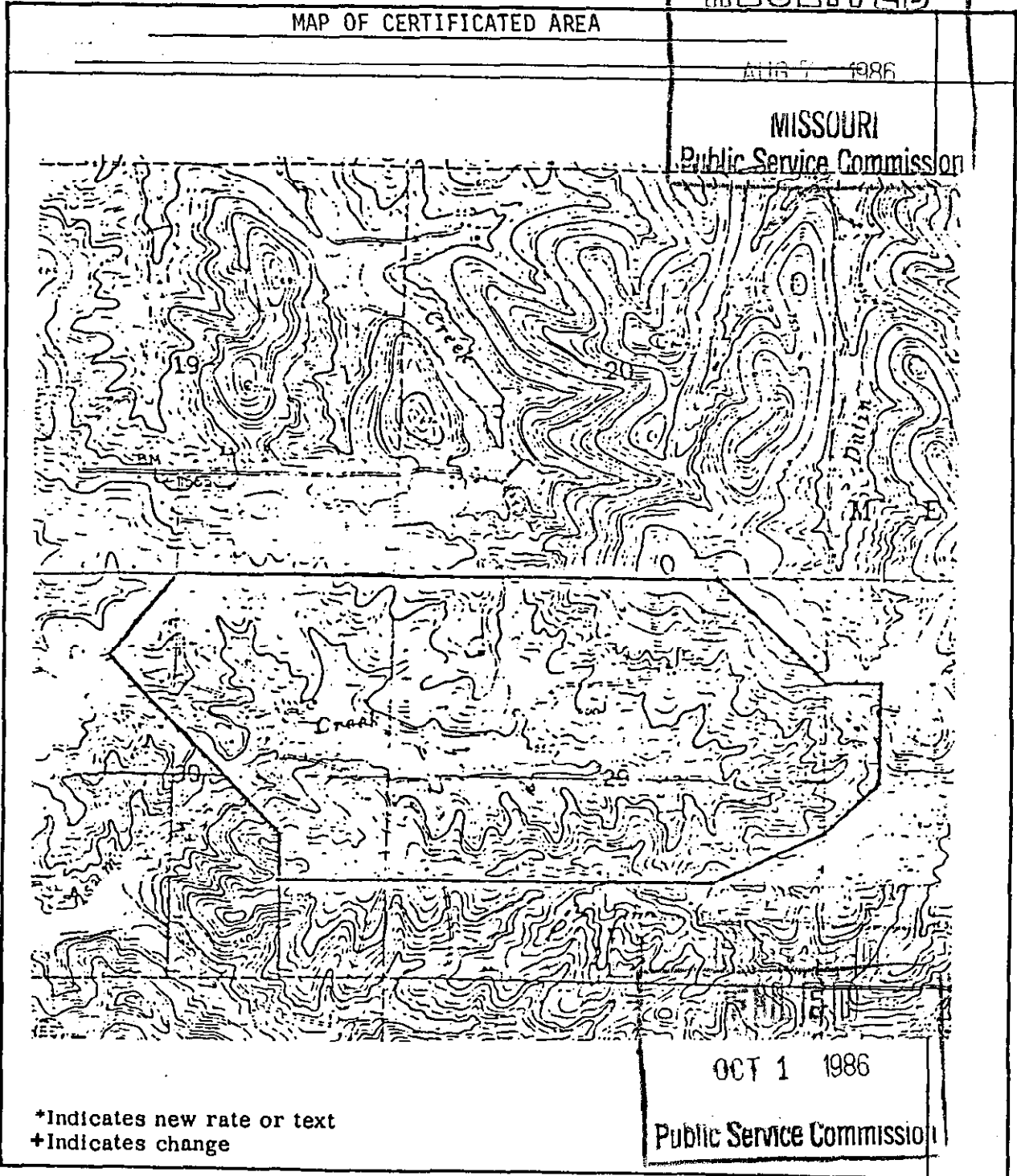

MAP OF CERTIFICATED AREA

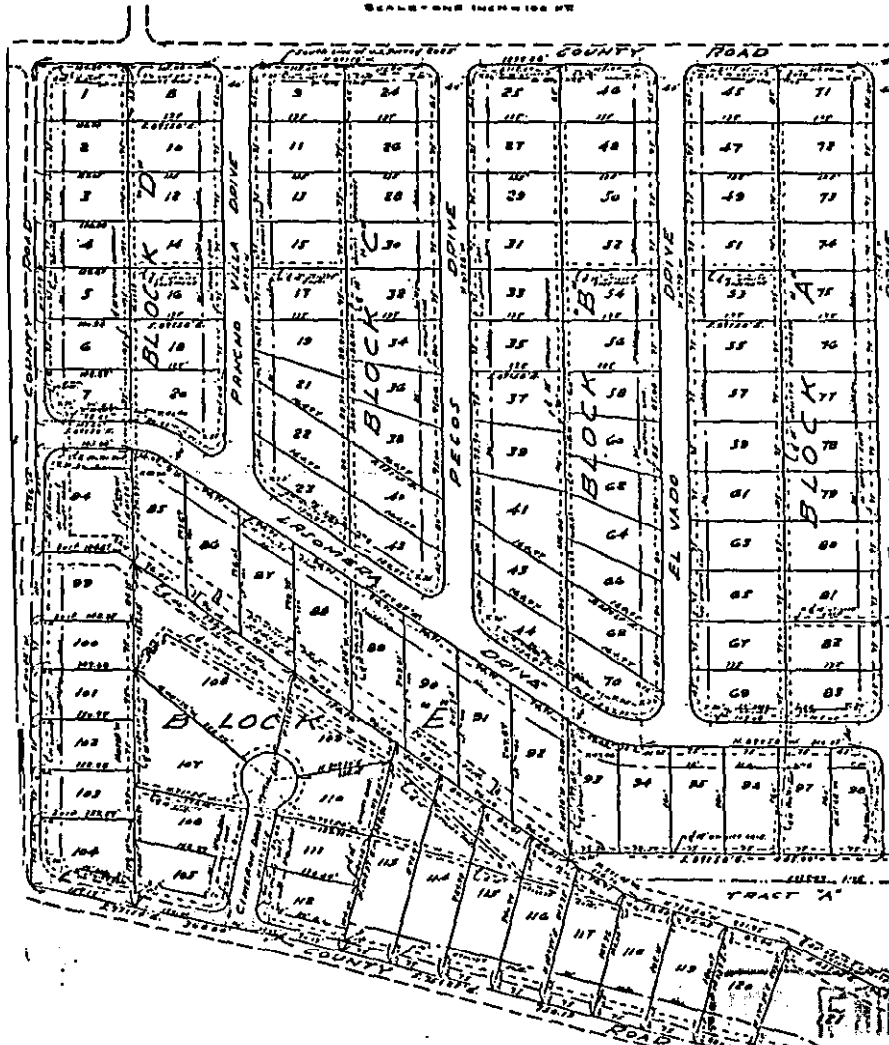
