ORDER APPROVING PGA TARIFF

Issue Date: October 25, 2017 Effective Date: November 1, 2017

On October 18, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, filed tariff sheets proposed to become effective November 1.¹ The tariff sheets reflect changes in Ameren Missouri's Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) factor.

The changes in the PGA factors applicable to the Company's service areas, excluding the Rolla area, will remain the same at 56.00¢/Ccf for firm sales customers. The interruptible sales customers' PGA factor will decrease to 32.69¢/Ccf from 33.64¢/Ccf1. The transportation PGA will remain unchanged at 0.00¢/Ccf.

The changes in the PGA factors applicable to the Company's Rolla system (Rolla, Salem, and Owensville) service area will increase the firm sales customers' PGA factor from 68.00¢/Ccf to 76.00¢/Ccf2. The interruptible sales customers' PGA factor will decrease to 33.94¢/Ccf from 34.89¢/Ccf3. The transportation PGA factor will remain unchanged at 0.00¢/Ccf. The Rolla system filing also reflects the discontinuation of the MoGas settlement credit that had been refunded to this system as a separate line item.

Staff filed its Recommendation on October 23. Staff states that this case was established to track the Company's PGA factors to be reviewed in its 2016-2017 Actual Cost Adjustment ("ACA") filing. Case No. GR-2016-0236 was established to track the Company's PGA factors to be reviewed in its 2015-2016 ACA filing. Staff recommends the Commission approve this rate change on an interim basis, subject to refund, pending final Commission decisions in ACA Case Nos. GR-2017-0341 and GR-2016-0236. Staff further asks the Commission to order the Procurement Analysis Unit of the Staff to file the results of its ACA review in this docket no later than December 17, 2018

Based on the verified filings,² the Commission will approve the tariff as Staff recommends. Further, because Ameren Missouri's PGA Clause allows for PGA change filings to take effect on 10 days' notice, the Commission will order the tariff to become effective on less than 30 days' notice.³

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The tariff assigned Tracking No. YG-2018-0044 is approved, on an interim basis and subject to refund, to become effective on November 1, 2017. The tariff sheet approved is:
