Metered Use Service Option B is a one-way, dial-in-dial-out multipoint service. Credit Card customers may originate calls from, and terminate calls to every city within the State of Missouri. Subscribers who originate calls from the locations listed in Section C-7, Table III can access MCI by dialing a 7 digit access number (950-1022). Subscribers who originate calls from locations other than those listed in Section C-7, Table III can access MCI via resold facilities by dialing a toll free 800 number. Two-tier pricing for both usage charges and surcharges is applicable and is based upon the two separate types of access. Option B may be provided as a Stand alone Service or as an Enhanced Service. If a customer subscribes solely to Option B he will be designated as a Standalone Credit Card Customer and will be assessed a one time \$10 initiation-of-service charge (Section C-3.0331).
