ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION TO INTERVENE

On October 22, 2018, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission seeking an order granting a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) pursuant to section 393.170, RSMo 2016. The CCN would authorize Ameren Missouri to construct, own, and operate a wind generation facility to be constructed in Atchison County in Missouri. Renew Missouri Advocates, d/b/a Renew Missouri applied to intervene on October 22.

More than ten days have passed since Renew Missouri applied to intervene and no one has responded to that application. After considering the unopposed application to intervene, the Commission finds that allowing Renew Missouri to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(3), the Commission will grant the application to intervene.

The Commission has also received applications to intervene from the Natural Resources Defense Council, Atchison County, DeKalb County, The Missouri Department of Conservation, and the Missouri Division of Energy. The time to respond to those applications has not yet passed, so they will not be addressed in this order. Instead, the Commission will address them at the procedural conference on November 6.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri's application to intervene is granted.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
