- 2 JUDGE STEARLEY: Good morning. Today is
- 3 Thursday, November 6th, 2008, and we are here for a
- 4 procedural conference in the case EA-2009-0118, In
- 5 the Matter of the Application of Aquila, Incorporated
- 6 for Permission and Approval and a Certificate of
- 7 Public Convenience and Necessity Authorizing it to
- 8 Acquire, Construct, Install, Own, Operate, Maintain
- 9 and Otherwise Control and Manage Electrical
- 10 Production and Related Facilities in Certain Areas of
- 11 Cass County, Missouri Near the City of Peculiar.
- 12 My name is Harold Stearley, and I'm the
- 13 presiding officer over this matter, and we'll begin
- 14 by taking entries of appearance, starting with KCP&L
- 15 Greater Missouri Operations Company.
- MR. ZOBRIST: Actually, Judge, it's
- 17 Aquila, Inc. dba Greater -- KCPL Greater Missouri
- 18 Operations Company. Karl Zobrist, Sonnenschein, Nath
- 19 & Rosenthal, 4520 Main Street, Kansas City, Missouri
- 20 64111, and Curtis D. Blanc on behalf of the company.
- 21 JUDGE STEARLEY: Thank you, Mr. Zobrist.
- 22 County of Cass.
- MR. COMLEY: Thank you, Judge Stearley.
- 24 Let the record reflect the entry of appearance of
- 25 Mark W. Comley, Newman, Comley & Ruth, 601 Monroe

- 1 Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. And also who's not
- 2 appearing today, also a representative of the county
- 3 is Cindy Means Martin. Her business address is 408
- 4 Southeast Douglas, Lee's Summit, Missouri 64063.
- JUDGE STEARLEY: Thank you, Mr. Comley.
- 6 Dogwood Energy, LLC.
- 7 MR. LUMLEY: Good morning, Judge. Carl
- 8 Lumley, the Curtis, Heinz law firm, 130 South
- 9 Bemiston, Suite 200, Clayton, Missouri 63105, appearing
- 10 on behalf of Dogwood Energy, LLC.
- 11 JUDGE STEARLEY: Thank you, Mr. Lumley.
- 12 Sedalia Industrial Energy Users Association.
- 13 MR. CONRAD: Stu Conrad on behalf of the
- 14 SIEUA Group, Finnegan, Conrad & Peterson. My office
- is 3100 Broadway, Suite 1209, Kansas City, Missouri
- 16 64111. Also, although he is not here today, David
- 17 Woodsmall of the same firm, 428 East Capitol Avenue,
- 18 Suite 300, Jefferson City, 65101.
- 19 JUDGE STEARLEY: Thank you, Mr. Conrad.
- 20 Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission.
- 21 MR. WILLIAMS: Nathan Williams, Post
- 22 Office Box 360, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102.
- JUDGE STEARLEY: Thank you,
- 24 Mr. Williams. And the Office of Public Counsel.
- MR. MILLS: Lewis Mills. My address is

- 1 Post Office Box 2230, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102.
- JUDGE STEARLEY: All right. Are there
- 3 any preliminary matters we need to address?
- 4 MR. WILLIAMS: Judge, I think a couple.
- 5 One, I should let you know as you may not be aware,
- 6 Aquila has filed a case within the past few days
- 7 where apparently they've changed the name of the
- 8 company to now be Kansas City -- KCP&L Greater
- 9 Missouri Operations Company. The Commission has not
- 10 acted on that request, so that's something that's in
- 11 the works.
- 12 And then the Staff and I think the other
- 13 parties would like to know if the Commission has any
- 14 process in mind in particular with regards to this
- 15 case, such as local public hearings.
- JUDGE STEARLEY: At this point the
- 17 Intervenors really didn't indicate a position one way
- 18 or the other on the application, so I thought what I
- 19 would do is a week from today, have you all file a
- 20 status report with me. If someone wants to request
- 21 an evidentiary hearing or a local public hearing,
- 22 they could make the request at that time.
- 23 And then I will also be taking the
- 24 matter to the Commissioners to see if they want to
- 25 have a local public hearing or an evidentiary hearing

- 1 as well. But I thought I would have the parties file
- 2 that for me jointly next Thursday the 13th after
- 3 you've had an opportunity to have some discussions.
- 4 That way you can kind of give me a sense of what
- 5 direction you want to go.
- 6 Obviously, if no one's in opposition, no
- 7 one may wish to have a hearing, in which case we'll
- 8 get a recommendation from Staff on the application.
- 9 MR. ZOBRIST: Judge, just as long as
- 10 we're on the record, I could clarify a couple of
- 11 things from what we stated in our application. I
- 12 understand that all the litigation now has been
- 13 resolved with regard to South Harper.
- 14 I think in our application we stated
- 15 that there was one outstanding claim. That was
- 16 resolved about two weeks ago. So to the best of our
- 17 knowledge, there are no outstanding claims or suits
- 18 with regard to either the South Harper plant or the
- 19 Peculiar substation.
- 20 And in the status report we can advise
- 21 as to the procedural schedule before the City of
- 22 Peculiar. As I understand it, there will be some
- 23 changes on the zoning application filed at the end of
- 24 this month. A hearing before the City of Peculiar
- 25 Planning Commission is scheduled for December 11th,

- 1 and then the ultimate approval would come from the
- 2 Peculiar Board of Aldermen, and that would be either
- 3 January 6th or January 20th, and we can set forth
- 4 that.
- 5 My understanding is that there is no
- 6 opposition to that application. All of the approvals
- 7 have been granted with regard to the South Harper
- 8 plant by Cass County.
- 9 JUDGE STEARLEY: Okay. Anything else we
- 10 need to pick up at this time? I did bring a couple
- 11 copies of our adjudication calendar --
- MR. WILLIAMS: Thank you.
- 13 JUDGE STEARLEY: -- if you did need to
- 14 look for any particular dates. And I guess I'll be
- 15 waiting to hear from you. If there's nothing else
- 16 for me to address at this time, we'll end our
- on-the-record portion of the procedural conference.
- 18 Thank you all very much.
- 19 (WHEREUPON, the recorded portion of the
- 20 procedural conference was concluded.)
