JUDGE DIPPELL: We can go ahead and go on the record. First, again I'd like to ask everyone if you're not going to be speaking be sure and stay muted. That helps us cut down on any extra noise and prevents the audio feedback.

Today is August 17, 2021. The Missouri Public Service Commission has set this time for a virtual local public hearing to give members of the public a chance to comment about Ameren Transmission Company of Illinois application in File No. EA-2021-0087, which is captioned In the Matter of the Application of Ameren Transmission Company of Illinois for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Construct, Install, Own, Operate, Maintain, and Otherwise Control and Manage a 138 kV Transmission Line and associated facilities in Perry and Cape Girardeau Counties in Missouri.

The Missouri Public Service Commission regulates the rates and services of investor-owned public utility companies in Missouri to ensure that those rates and services are just and reasonable. The Commission also regulates the quality of service and the safety of operations of public utilities.

The Commission is made up of five

Commissioners. The Commissioners are appointed by the

Governor to fixed terms and confirmed by the Missouri Senate. The Commissioners employ a staff of engineers, accountants, attorneys, financial analysts and other specialists in the field of utility regulation.

My name is Nancy Dippell. I'm the Regulatory
Law Judge and I will be presiding over this hearing. We
have on the virtual conference with us tonight some of
the Commissioners. Commissioner Kolkmeyer I know is
present. I haven't heard specifically the other
Commissioners jump on, but they may be in and out as the
hearing continues. Thank you, Commissioner, for joining
us this evening.

This is an official hearing of the Missouri Public Service Commission, and the statements and testimony of the witnesses will be recorded by a court reporter and must be given under oath or affirmation. The Commission has not made any decisions in this case and cannot answer any questions today because they must remain impartial as myself also until after all of the evidence is presented in this case.

Commissioner Kolkmeyer, did you have any opening remarks you wanted to say at all?

COMMISSIONER KOLKMEYER: I want to thank everyone for being on here and giving their testimony. Thank you for joining us.

JUDGE DIPPELL: Thank you, Ms. Bell. Okay. The process that we're going to follow tonight is that we had a list for preregistrations. I think we only had one person actually preregister, but I will call the names that we have on that list and then when I call your name if you go ahead and unmute I'll ask you to swear or affirm to tell the truth and I will ask you to state your name and to spell it. Then you can give us your comments for the Commission.
