ORDER APPROVING DEMAND SIDE INVESTMENT MECHANISM RIDER RATE ADJUSTMENT TARIFF

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Issue Date: July 19, 2018 Effective Date: August 1, 2018

On June 1, 2018, Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCP&L) filed a tariff, with supporting testimony, to adjust charges related to its approved Demand Side Investment Mechanism (DSIM) rider. The submitted tariff sheet carries an effective date of August 1, 2018. The Commission issued notice of the filing, set an intervention deadline, and directed the Commission's Staff to submit a recommendation. No one filed an application to intervene. Staff submitted its recommendation on July 2, advising the Commission to approve KCP&L's tariff. No party has filed a response to Staff's recommendation.

Commission Rules 4 CSR 240-20.093(4) and 4 CSR 240-3.163(8) require KCP&L to make semi-annual adjustments of its DSIM rates to reflect the amount of revenue that has been over or under-collected. The proposed tariff sheet decreases the current residential DSIM Rider rate from \$0.00665 per kWh to \$0.00424 per kWh for residential customers and from \$0.00592 per kWh to \$0.00313 per kWh for non-residential customers. KCP&L's requested adjustment would decrease the bill of a residential customer by \$2.41 for every 1,000 kWhs used. It would decrease a non-residential customer's bill by \$2.79 for every 1,000 kWhs used. The DSIM Rider rate change will decrease KCP&L's overall revenue collected through residential and non-residential rates by \$8.3 million.

The Commission's rule 4 CSR 240-20.093(4) regarding adjustment of DSIM rates between general rate proceedings states that if the proposed adjustments are in accordance with the rule, Section 393.1075, RSMo, and the previously-approved DSIM, the Commission shall issue an order approving the tariff sheets, and the adjustments shall take effect sixty days after the tariff is filed. The Commission has reviewed KCP&L's tariff filings and Staff's recommendation and memorandum, and finds that the proposed tariff sheet implementing the DSIM rate adjustment is in compliance with KCP&L's existing DSIM tariffs and with all applicable statutes and regulations. The Commission will approve KCP&L's tariff.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Kansas City Power & Light Company's tariff filing, assigned Tariff Tracking No. JE-2018-0161, is approved to be effective August 1, 2018, as an interim rate adjustment, subject to prudence review. The tariff sheet approved is:
