Dear Secretary of the Commission:

Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri, is filing the following tariff changes to comply with the directives of the Federal Communications Commission's November 18, 2011 USF/ICC Transformation Order, FCC 11-161 (WC Docket No. 10-90). This order requires that intrastate access rates for 1) terminating End Office Access Service, 2) terminating Tandem—Switched Transport Access Service, and 3) originating and terminating Dedicated Transport Access Service be no higher than their functionally equivalent interstate access rates effective July 2, 2013. This filing implements those required rate reductions.

Further, the switched access services tariff (Section 6, P.S.C. Mo.-No. 36) has been reorganized to follow the respective interstate switched access services tariff (Section 6, Southwestern Bell Telephone Co. FCC No. 1). This effort was undertaken for overall administrative ease and tariff simplification for the customer. The Commission Staff may also find this approach helpful in facilitating the review of rates and rate structures going forward. The Missouri switched access service section will now concur with the interstate tariff. Any exceptions from that concurrence will be listed in detail in the Missouri switched access service section.

Also, Section 39 has been added to the Missouri tariff to correspond with certain switched access services residing in the respective Section 39 of the interstate access tariff.

Lastly, a certification has been attached which confirms that this filing is not seeking duplicative recovery in the state and interstate jurisdictions¹

The issued and effective dates of these revisions are May 10 and June 10, 2013 respectively.

¹ Specifically, 47 C.F.R. §51.915(d)(3) requires Price Cap Carriers to certify annually to the FCC and to relevant state commissions that the carrier is not seeking duplicative recovery in the state jurisdiction for any Eligible Recovery subject to the federal recovery mechanisms.
