C. EXPLANATION OF TERMS:

Public Service Commission

1. Service Order: Receiving and recording information and/or taking action in connection with a subscriber or applicant and processing the necessary data.
2. Access Line Work: Work associated with the line extending from serving central office to the customer's premises. Includes, but is not limited to, central office connections, cable cross connections and connecting and disconnecting the drop or block-wires.
3. Station Work: Performing work at the customer's premises. Includes, but is not limited to, installing, moving, changing inside wiring and connecting, moving or changing one line terminal equipment and applies for each additional equipment work unit on the same premises and under the same work order. Does not include Key Telephone Stations or other special equipment covered elsewhere in this tariff.
 - a. First Station: For the first termination done on a trip to the customer's premises.
 - b. Additional Stations: For each additional termination when done at the same time the first station charge shown above applies.
4. Key Telephone Stations: The charge applies only to each station. No reduction is given for additional stations when installed at the same time because of the number of wires and special equipment associated with this service. This does not include the access line work associated with Key Telephone Service, which is covered in 2 above.
5. PBX/PABX Trunks and Stations: The stations are normally one line type stations and are covered under station work, 3, above.
6. Reconnection: Reestablishment of service for nonpayment when a service order has not been issued for a final bill, only the charge shown will apply. If a service order has been issued the respective charges for Service Order, Access Line Work, Station Work, ~~at~~ ^{with} ~~the~~ ^{the} PBX as applicable.

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D. CONDITIONS

Public Service Commission

1. Service Connection Charges are payable at the time the work is performed and are in addition to the rates and any other applicable charges which may be established and made a part of this filed tariff.
2. Service Connection Charges apply in addition to, but not in lieu of, mileage charges or those charges incurred through Special Type of Construction or Line Extensions of a temporary speculative nature.
3. Service Connection Charges Apply To:
 - a. Establishing service.
 - b. Reestablishment of service for nonpayment when a service order has been issued for a final bill.
 - c. Move of service from one premise to another.
 - d. Assumption of service with a change in responsibility.
 - e. Changing color, type or location of instrument when no other Service Connection Charges apply.
 - f. Number change made at the request of the customer when no other Service Connection Charges apply.
4. Service Connection Charges Do Not Apply:
 - a. When any change is made and initiated by the Company, either in type or color or instrument, customer's telephone number, etc.
 - b. When telephone service is reestablished at a secondary location immediately following the rendering of the customer's primary location as unfit for occupancy due to fire, flood, etc. At the option of the Company, the same telephone number may be used.
 - c. To supplement equipment or miscellaneous services filed elsewhere in this tariff unless specifically stated.

SERVICE CONNECTION - LINK UP MISSOURI

MO. PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

A. General Regulations

The Link up Missouri Service Connection Program is a Federal Lifeline assistance program applicable to eligible residential subscribers, as defined below, and designed to promote subscribership to the telephone network among low income residential households.

1. Service Connection Charges, as set forth in this tariff*, for initial installation of the main residential service access line, will be discounted at a rate of 50 percent, or \$30.00, whichever is less. These reduced charges shall be assessed only for a single residential telephone line per eligible household at the principle place of residence. +
2. The customer may defer payment on up to \$200 of the above charges without interest for a period not to exceed one year. The deferred charges do not include any permissible security deposits required. Payments shall be equally paid over a twelve month period *
3. A qualifying low-income customer may choose with 1 or 2, or both 1 and 2 as described above.
4. Link Up assistance is available for a second or subsequent time only for a principal place of residence with an address different from the residence address where assistance was previously provided.
5. The premises at which the residence service is requested must be the applicant's principal place of residence.
6. There is only one telephone line serving the residence premises. The residence premises household (dwelling unit) shall consist of that portion of an individual house or building or one flat or apartment occupied by a single family or individuals functioning as one domestic establishment.
7. Link Up will not be furnished on a Foreign Exchange service.

* The discount established herein does not apply to other charges that may be required at the initiation of service such as security deposit, contributions in aid of construction, customer advances, etc.

E. APPLICABILITY OF LINK UP MISSOURI SERVICE CONNECTION PROGRAM

1. The Link Up Missouri Service Connection Program is a Federal Lifeline assistance program applicable to eligible residential subscribers, as defined below, and designed to promote subscription to the telephone network among low income residential households.
 - a. Service Connection Charges, as set forth in this tariff¹, for initial installation of the main residential service access line, will be discounted at a rate of 50 percent, not to exceed \$30.00. These reduced charges shall be assessed only for a single residential telephone line per eligible household at the principle place of residence.

2. Eligibility Requirements.

The following requirements shall be used by the company to determine the eligibility of a subscriber for Link Up Missouri assistance.

- a. Subscribers must have lived at an address where there has been no telephone service for at least three months prior to the date that assistance is requested.
- b. Eligible subscribers must not have received assistance within the last two years. **CANCELLED**
- c. Subscribers must not be a dependent for federal income tax purposes, unless the subscriber is more than 60 years of age. **JAN 01 1998**
- d. Subscriber is currently receiving Medicaid/medical assistance payments from the State of Missouri and has provided their Department of Social Services Client Number (DCN) to the Company. **By: [Signature] #4
