On November 5, 2014, the Commission issued an *Order Approving Partial Stipulation and Agreement, Rejecting Tariff, and Establishing Procedural Schedule*, which rejected the tariff sheets previously submitted by KCP&L Greater Operations Company ("GMO") and authorized GMO to file new tariff sheets in compliance with its order. On November 6, 2014, GMO filed compliance tariff sheets bearing an effective date of December 6, 2014 and a motion for expedited treatment requesting that the tariff sheets be permitted to become effective on December 1, 2014.

The Commission set a response deadline, and on November 17, 2014, the Commission's Staff filed a recommendation for the Commission to approve the tariff filings and grant the motion for expedited treatment. No other party responded or opposed approval of the tariffs or the motion. The Commission has reviewed the tariff filings and Staff's verified recommendation, and the Commission will approve the tariff sheets and grant expedited treatment.
