ORDER APPROVING TARIFF IN COMPLIANCE WITH COMMISSION
ORDER AND CANCELING FIDELITY'S CERTIFICATE

In an order issued on February 21, 2006, the Commission approved a unanimous stipulation and agreement for the sale of Fidelity Natural Gas, Inc.'s assets to Laclede Gas Company. Laclede Gas Company filed a tariff sheet on March 31, 2006, designed to comply with paragraph 7 of the Commission's February 21 order. On April 14, 2006, the Staff of the Commission filed a Recommendation and Memorandum stating that the tariff filing comports with the order of the Commission and recommending that the Commission approve the tariff sheet filed on March 31 with an effective date of May 1. The Staff further recommended that the certificate granted to Fidelity in Case No. GA-91-299 be canceled.

Based on Staff's recommendation, the Commission determines that the tariff complies with the Commission's order, and will be approved. The tariff will be approved

effective for service on and after May 1, 2006. The Commission will also cancel Fidelity's certificate.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The following tariff sheet filed March 31, 2006, and assigned Tariff No. YG-2006-0746, is approved to become effective on May 1, 2006:
