ORDER APPROVING TARIFF TO CHANGE FUEL ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE RATES

Issue Date: May 21, 2014 Effective Date: May 27, 2014

On March 28, 2014¹, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren") filed a tariff to adjust the company's rates pursuant to its Fuel Adjustment Clause (FAC). In accordance with Ameren's FAC, the proposed rate schedules are designed to recover from customers 95 percent of the company's net cost increases or decreases. The requested adjustment would increase a typical residential customer's bill by approximately \$0.66 per month.

The Commission's Staff filed a recommendation regarding Ameren's tariff on April 28. Staff verified that Ameren's actual fuel and purchased power costs match the fuel and purchased power costs included in the company's calculated rates set in the submitted tariffs. Staff advises the Commission to approve the tariff submitted by Ameren to become effective on its May 27 effective date.

More than ten days have passed since Staff filed its recommendation, and no party has filed a response to that recommendation.²

Based on the Direct Testimony of Erik Wenberg, submitted by Ameren along with its tariff, as well as the uncontested recommendation of Staff, the Commission will approve Ameren's proposed rate schedule.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The rate schedule submitted by Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri as Tariff No. JE-2014-0372, is approved as an interim rate adjustment, subject to true-up and prudence reviews, to become effective on May 27, 2014. The tariff sheet approved is:
