## 3.1.6 Items with Termination Charge

When any item of equipment, which is subject to a termination charge that is located on the customer's premises, is moved and is installed at a new location, at the request of the customer, the customer may elect to:

- A. Pay the unexpired portion of the termination charge for the item and applicable non-recurring charges with a new termination charge for such items made effective at the new location, or
- B. Continue service subject to the unexpired portion of the termination charge, and pay the total cost incurred by the Telephone Company of moving such equipment; provided the customer requests a firm commitment as to such charges prior to placing an order. Charges for moving such equipment will be determined on the basis of estimates of such costs.

Cost of moving includes cost of removal, restoration of equipment necessitated by the move, transportation, storage, reinstallation and shall include costs of engineering, labor, supervision, materials, administration, taxes and any other specific items of cost directly attributable to the move.


