ORDER APPROVING COMPLIANCE TARIFF TO BECOME EFFECTIVE ON OCTOBER 7, 2021

Issue Date: September 21, 2021 Effective Date: October 7, 2021

On June 28, 2021,¹ Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC) filed a petition to establish an Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge (ISRS) applicable to its St. Louis County service area. On September 15, the Commission issued its Order Approving Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge and Rejecting Tariff. That order approved ISRS surcharge revenues, rejected tariff JW-2021-0261 and ordered MAWC to file compliance tariff sheets conforming with the ISRS rate otherwise established in the order.

On September 15, MAWC filed a Motion for Expedited Treatment and Tariff Revision JW-2022-0056 ("compliance tariff") with an effective date of October 15. MAWC asked that the compliance tariff be approved to take effect for service rendered on and after October 7, or as soon thereafter as was reasonable. On September 15, the Commission ordered the Commission's Staff (Staff) to file a recommendation on the compliance tariff no later than 9:00 a.m. on September 20 and also set that day and time as a deadline for any third-party pleading objecting or responding to the compliance tariff.

On September 16, the Staff filed its Recommendation for Approval of Compliance tariff. Therein Staff stated that the compliance tariff complied with the Commission's September 15 order and that Staff did not oppose MAWC's request for expedited treatment. No other party has filed a pleading objecting to or commenting on the compliance tariff. The Commission will approve the compliance tariff to become effective on October 7 and, in order to do so, also make this order effective on October 7.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission approves the following compliance tariff:
