Dear Mr. Woodruff:

The accompanying tariff sheets issued by Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (Ameren Missouri or the Company) are being transmitted for filing as revisions of Schedule No 2, Schedule of Rates for Gas:

These tariff sheets are being issued April 15, 2015 to become effective on and after May 15, 2015.

The Company is filing the same revisions to both the Electric and Gas Budget Billing provisions to improve customer satisfaction with the program, reduce complaints and inquiries on the program, and to increase the Company's efficiency in managing the program.

The proposed changes include:

- 1. Changing the default settlement process to rollover;
- 2. Synchronizing budget bill adjustments to occur in May and November;
- 3. Synchronizing annual settlement to occur in either May or November;
- 4. Setting a minimum Budget Bill amount for new customers with less than 12 month bill history to be \$100: and
- 5. Allowing customers moving within Ameren Missouri to roll over settlement balances to the new account (implement in July).

These tariff revisions will help to eliminate the largest concern that customers have with the program which is being required to pay a large settlement amount due to actual billing being different than historical billing.

These proposed changes have been discussed with Staff and OPC and they have voiced no objections to these changes.
