Upon issuance of a Missouri Public Service Commission Order directing a calling study, the Company will conduct a study covering a one-month billing period of Long Distance Message Telecommunications Service Dial Station-to-Station traffic from the COS Petitioning Exchange to the COS Target Exchange.
- 6. The Missouri Public Service Commission has ruled that a community of interest is found to exist when the traffic studies show that both of the following criteria are met:
 - a. Customers in the COS Petitioning Exchange make an average of at least six calls per access line per month to the COS Target Exchange;

- 7. If the above criteria have been satisfied and/or the Missouri Public Service Commission determines that a community of interest exists, the COS Petitioning Exchange will be certified as a COS qualifying exchange and the service will be implemented on a time schedule approved by the Missouri Public Service Commission.

C. Conditions

- 1. COS will be offered as a two-way optional flat rate service. Two-way optional flat rate service allows customers to make unlimited calls to and receive unlimited calls from the COS Target Exchange Calling Scope for a recurring monthly flat rate.
- 2. The Calling Scope of the two-way COS route shall be to the COS Targeted Exchange plus its EAS exchanges. Any EAS additives applicable in the COS Target Exchange would apply to the COS subscriber in addition to the COS monthly flat rate.
