ORDER SETTING EVIDENTIARY HEARING

The parties have been unable to resolve this dispute. The Missouri Public Service Commission will therefore set this matter for an evidentiary hearing. Because of the limited amount of testimony expected, it will not be necessary for the parties to file testimony prior to the hearing.

During a prehearing conference the Commission determined that Marlyn Young, complainant, will mark his exhibits alphabetically beginning with the complaint as "Exhibit A". Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE will mark its exhibits numerically, beginning with "Exhibit #2." The Staff of the Commission will submit its Report marked as "Exhibit #1."

Because Complainant is representing himself, he will be allowed to first give a statement of his complaint. His statement will also serve as an opening statement. Questions directed toward complainant will proceed as follows: the bench, Staff, then

AmerenUE. Complainant will then be afforded an opportunity to finally address any subjects raised by those questions directed toward him. Thereafter, Staff will present its evidence. Questions toward Staff will proceed as follows: the bench, AmerenUE, then Complainant with redirect following. Finally, Ameren will present its evidence with questions first from the bench, then Staff, then Complainant concluding with redirect.

The parties will not be required to file post-hearing briefs but will instead give closing argument.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. An evidentiary hearing shall be held on September 12, 2007, beginning at 10:00 a.m., in Room 310 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This hearing will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
