COMPLAINANT'S MOTION TO RECONSIDER DISMISSAL


Comes now the complainant, Richard Tolbert, with a motion to reconsider the dismissal of the complaint, and states in support:

1. The complainant was a tenant, resident, and co-owner of the Premises. On page 7 of the dismissal, it is stated that "There is no dispute that Mr. Tolbert is neither the owner nor tenant or permanent resident of the Premises:..." The facts are that the complainant was all three. The other co-owner, with whom the complainant is involved in a partnership dispute, falsely told the commission that no management agreement existed. The complainant provided a copy of that agreement to the commission.

2. It would be reasonable and just to allow the complainant to amend his complaint and sign it for himself as a tenant and resident, if the problem here is that the complaint is "...effectively unsigned, making it subject to rejection or dismissal." (Page 8 of the dismissal.)

WHEREFORE, the complainant requests reinstatement of the complaint and the opportunity to "well-plead" the facts.
