ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY
AND TARIFF

Issue Date: April 19, 2007

Effective Date: April 29, 2007

On March 29, 2007, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion to cancel the certificate of service authority granted to Cypress Telecommunications Corporation. Staff states that Cypress was granted a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange in Case No. TA-94-347. In that same case, the Commission approved the company's tariff, P.S.C. MO No. 1.

Staff further states that the company has requested that its certificate of service authority be canceled as it is not providing any services in Missouri. Staff finally states that the company has no past due annual reports or assessment and that no complaints have been filed against the company since the Commission began its Electronic Filing and Information System.

Under Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) parties shall not be allowed more than ten days in which to file a responsive pleading. More than ten days have expired since Staff filed its motion and Cypress has not responded.

Section 392.410.5, RSMo 2000, states: "Any certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or

upon application of the person or company affected. . . .” The Commission has reviewed Staff’s motion and finds that granting the motion is reasonable. The Commission will therefore cancel the certificate of service authority granted to Cypress in Case No. TA-94-34.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telephone service granted to Cypress Telecommunications Corporation. in Case Nos. TA-94-34 is canceled.
2. The tariff, P.S.C. MO No. 1, approved for Cypress Telecommunications Corporation is canceled.
3. This order shall become effective on April 29, 2007.
4. This case shall be closed on April 30, 2007.
