ORDER APPROVING TARIFF IN COMPLIANCE WITH COMMISSION ORDER

Issue Date: December 1, 2020 Effective Date: December 18, 2020 On November 18, 2020, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed revised tariff sheets designed to implement the terms of the *Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement Regarding the Implementation Certain MEEIA Programs Through Plan Year 2022* approved by the Commission.¹ The revised tariff sheets include revisions to the Pay as You Save® (PAYS®) program which will be made available in 2021. The revised tariff sheets have a December 18, 2020 effective date.

The Commission ordered its Staff to file a recommendation and any other party wishing to respond to the tariff sheets do so by November 30, 2020. Staff filed its recommendation, stating that it examined the tariff sheets and found them to be to be in compliance with the terms of the approved stipulation and agreement. No other responses were received.

After reviewing the tariff sheets and the Staff recommendation, the Commission concludes that Ameren Missouri's tariff sheets comply with the approved stipulation and agreement and the Commission's order and will approve them.
