ORDER APPROVING PARTIAL STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT, REJECTING TARIFF, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Effective Date: November 15, 2014

On October 20, 2014, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("GMO"), the Office of Public Counsel, Earth Island Institute d/b/a Renew Missouri, and the Commission's Staff filed a *Non-Unanimous Partial Stipulation and Agreement* ("Agreement"). The Commission may resolve any part of this proceeding on the basis of a stipulation and agreement.¹ Since no party filed a timely objection to the Agreement, the Commission will treat the Agreement as a unanimous stipulation and agreement.² After reviewing the Agreement, the Commission independently finds and concludes that the Agreement is a reasonable resolution of the issues addressed by the Agreement and that such Agreement should be approved.

On September 22, 2014, the Commission suspended until December 31, 2014 the tariff sheets submitted on April 10, 2014 by GMO under Tariff Tracking Number

YE-2014-0407. The Commission will reject those tariff sheets and authorize GMO to file new tariff sheets in compliance with this order. In addition, the Agreement states that there are two remaining issues for Commission determination and proposes a procedural schedule in order to resolve those issues. The Commission will adopt the proposed procedural schedule.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Non-Unanimous Partial Stipulation and Agreement filed on October 20,

2014, is approved as a resolution of the issues addressed in that stipulation and agreement. The signatory parties are ordered to comply with the terms of the *Non-Unanimous Partial Stipulation and Agreement*. A copy of the stipulation and agreement is attached to this order and incorporated herein as if fully set forth.

2. The tariff sheets submitted on April 10, 2014, by KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company, assigned Tariff Tracking No. YE-2014-0407, are rejected. The specific sheets rejected are:

sheets in compliance with this order and a motion for expedited treatment.
