To date, the Company has provided customers with the option of having the Company install and maintain extensions between buildings on the same premises for a monthly recurring charge that includes the Company's ongoing maintenance of that wiring. The Company will continue to maintain wiring between buildings that has been installed to date at the on-premises extension rates specified herein. Effective November 1, 2013, for new installations of on-premises installations between buildings on the customer's side of the Network Interface Device (NID), such will be installed by the Company upon customer request on a time and materials basis. The customer is responsible for ongoing maintenance of such installations, but may at their choosing, subscribe to a Company provided Inside Wire Maintenance Plan for a recurring monthly charge to provide maintenance coverage for the extension wiring and all other inside wiring/jacks located on the customer's side of the NID.
