**ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

Doug and Nancy Geno filed a formal complaint against Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, on May 7, 2009.<sup>1</sup> AmerenUE filed its Answer and Motion to Dismiss on June 10. The Commission ordered its Staff to file a verified report concerning the complaint no later than June 26.

On June 22, Staff filed a Motion for Extension of Time. Staff alluded to safety concerns which requires it to make an on-site visit and to send data requests. As a consequence, Staff requests an extension of time until July 31 to submit its report.

The Commission finds Staff's request reasonable, and will grant it.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Motion for Extension of Time is granted.
2. The Staff of the Commission shall file a verified report concerning the above-referenced complaint no later than July 31, 2009.

3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
