**ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME AND SETTING DEADLINE  
TO FILE CONFLICT DATES FOR CONVENING  
AN EVIDENTIARY HEARING**

On August 19, 2011, Eric E. Vickers ("Complainant") requested an extension of time through September 1, 2011 to respond to the Commission's August 10, 2011 "Order Dismissing Complaint in Part and Granting Leave to Amend Complaint." Complainant states he needs additional time to respond because of his trial schedule. The Commission finds the request to be reasonable and will grant it.<sup>1</sup>

This complaint was commenced in April and the Commission plans to convene an evidentiary hearing for this matter in October. Consequently, the parties will be directed to file their list of conflict dates for October no later than September 2, 2011.

<sup>1</sup> Complainant has not identified himself to this Commission as an attorney, and has stated that his status as an attorney is irrelevant to his complaint because he is proceeding *pro se*. Complainant provides no list of trials or case numbers in which he is involved, but the Commission will presume he is in compliance with the Commission's pleading rules and the rules of professional responsibility for attorneys when asserting that his trial schedule is the basis for his requested extension.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The deadline for Eric E. Vickers to file a response to the Commission's August 10, 2011 "Order Dismissing Complaint in Part and Granting Leave to Amend Complaint" is extended until midnight of September 1, 2011.

2. The parties shall file their lists of conflict dates for convening an evidentiary hearing in the month of October 2011 no later than September 2, 2011.

3. In addition to serving Complainant electronically with this order, the Commission's Data Center shall also send a copy of this order to Complainant by regular mail.

4. The Commission's Data Center shall update the style of this file in the Commission's Electronic Information and Filing System to reflect the effect of the Commission's August 10, 2011 "Order Dismissing Complaint in Part and Granting Leave to Amend Complaint." The style shall appear as it is captioned in this order.

5. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
