ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL CONFERENCE

On April 28, 2021, Ameren Transmission Company of Illinois (ATXI) filed an application requesting a certificate of convenience and necessity to construct, install, own, operate, maintain, and otherwise control and manage a 138 kV transmission line and associated facilities in Perry and Cape Girardeau counties. ATXI requests a Commission order no later than December 30, 2021.

On May 5, 2021, the Commission directed notice of the application and set a deadline for intervention applications. On May 19, 2021, ATXI filed a motion for adoption of a procedural schedule and proposed the Commission schedule a local public hearing by telephone and video conference. On June 4, 2021, Terry and Mary Frances Scholl filed an application to intervene. Any objections to the Scholl application are due, by rule, no later than June 14, 2021.¹

The Commission will set a procedural conference to discuss a local public hearing, a hearing date, and other procedural issues. The procedural conference will be held at

the Commission's offices in Jefferson City, and parties may also appear by telephone conference call.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. All parties shall appear at a procedural conference at **1:15 p.m. on June 21, 2021.**

2. The procedural conference will convene by telephone conference call and in person in Room 305 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. The building meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. Those who require additional accommodations to participate in the conference may call the Public Service Commission's hotline at 1 (800) 392-4211 (voice) or Relay Missouri at 711 before the conference.

3. The telephone conference can be accessed by dialing, toll-free, 1 (855) 718-6621 and entering access code **177 883 2781**, followed by #, at the time set for the conference. Any party who is unable to connect via the toll-free number may dial 1 (650) 479-3207 and enter the access code above, followed by #, at the time set for the conference.

4. This order shall be effective when issued.
