## ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME FOR STAFF RECOMMENDATION AND DIRECTING FILING OF PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On December 21, 2021, Ameren Transmission Company of Illinois (ATXI) filed an application with the Commission seeking an order granting a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) pursuant to section 393.170, RSMo 2016. The CCN would authorize ATXI to construct, acquire, own, operate, and maintain certain transmission facilities in, around, and between the cities of New Madrid and Sikeston, Missouri. ATXI states that the requested CCN and related approvals will enable it to participate in a collaborative effort among ATXI, New Madrid, Sikeston (including the Sikeston Board of Municipal Utilities), and the Missouri Joint Municipal Electric Utility Commission. ATXI requests expedited treatment in that it seeks Commission approval of its CCN no later than May 2, 2022.

On February 23, 2022, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a *Staff Recommendation* in which it made no recommendation regarding ATXI's application. Instead, Staff asked that it be given until March 9, 2022, to file its recommendation. Staff also requested that the Commission direct the parties to establish a procedural schedule.

The Commission will grant Staff's request for additional time to file its

recommendation. The Commission will also grant Staff's request to direct the parties to establish a procedural schedule and will treat Staff's request as a request for a hearing.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Staff's request for additional time to file its recommendation is granted. Staff shall file its recommendation as soon as possible, but no later than March 9, 2022.

2. The parties shall collaborate on a joint proposed procedural schedule to be filed by Staff no later than March 3, 2022.

3. This order shall be effective when issued.
