**ORDER OF CORRECTION AND
DIRECTING CORRECTED NEWSPAPER NOTICE**

Issue Date: February 24, 2023

Effective Date: February 24, 2023

The Commission issued an *Order Setting Local Public Hearings and Directing Notice* on February 8, 2023. Virtual local public hearings are scheduled for March 6 and 8, with an in-person local public hearing scheduled for March 7. That order indicated in the instructions for participating by telephone or video that the person should enter the “meeting number” for the hearing, but elsewhere in the order refers to the “access code” for the public hearings, without listing a “meeting number.”

On February 23, the Missouri Landowners Alliance and the Eastern Missouri Landowners Alliance d/b/a Show Me Concerned Landowners (Landowners) filed a motion asking that Grain Belt Express, LLC be ordered to republish newspaper notices regarding the local public hearings to clarify the proper “meeting number” to be used to access the virtual local public hearings. Because of the limited amount of time remaining before the virtual local public hearings, the Landowners ask the Commission to order Grain Belt to republish the notices as soon as possible.

The “access code” and “meeting number” are two names for the same number. However, the Commission’s order and the previously published notice based on that

order could confuse members of the public who wish to participate in the virtual local public hearings. In order to avoid any confusion, the Commission will direct Grain Belt to place additional advertisement of the hearings in newspapers serving the three counties with the clear instructions for accessing the virtual local public hearings.

2. Ordered Paragraph 6 of the February 8, 2023 *Order Setting Local Public Hearings and Directing Notice* is corrected to read as follows:

To attend a WebEx public hearing by telephone, at the time of the hearing call toll free 1-855-718-6621, listen to the prompt and enter the access code for that meeting as indicated in paragraph 1 of this order, followed by # (the pound/hashtag symbol). If prompted for a password, enter 0017. To participate in a WebEx hearing by video/internet, visit the website at www.webex.com, or download the WebEx Meetings application on your mobile device before the hearing and join the meeting at the hearing time by inputting the access code and password for that meeting as indicated in paragraph 1 of this order.

3. Grain Belt shall provide corrected notice of the local public hearings as soon as possible by placing corrected advertisements in newspapers serving Audrain, Callaway, and Monroe Counties.

4. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make notice of this order available to the members of the media and the General Assembly representing customers in Audrain, Callaway, and Monroe Counties.

5. The Commission's Data Center shall provide a copy of this order to the county commissions for Audrain, Callaway, and Monroe Counties.

6. This order is effective when issued.
