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Page 5 PROCEEDINGS 1 JUDGE STEARLEY: Good morning. 2 It's 3 Monday, October the 15th, 2012. The Commission set this 4 time for a procedural conference in two related matters. First is File No. EA-2013-0098, which is 5 6 captioned as In the Matter of Application of Transource 7 Missouri, L.L.C. for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity Authorizing it to Construct, Finance, Own, 8 9 Operate, and Maintain the Iatan-Nashua and Sibley-Nebraska City Electric Transmission Project. The second is File 10 No. EO-2012-0367, In the Matter of the Application of 11 12 Kansas City Power and Light Company and KCP&L Greater 13 Missouri Operations Company for Approval to Transfer Certain Transmission Property to Transource Missouri, 14 L.L.C. and for other Related Determinations. 15 My name is Harold Stearley, and I am the 16 17 Law Judge presiding over today's conference. We will start with the appearances, starting with Transource. 18 19 MR. ZOBRIST: Karl Zobrist, with SNR Denton 20 US, LLP, along with my colleague, Teresa Gilbreath, 4520 21 Main Street, Suite 1100, Kansas City, Missouri, 641116. Also, who would be here today are Denise M. Buffington, 22 Kansas City Power and Light Company. She's a member of 23 24 the Bars of the District of Columbia and State of Kansas, 25

Page 6 and Larry W. Brewer, Assistant General Counsel from 1 American Electric Power Company, Austin, Texas, who is a 2 3 member of the State Bar of Texas. 4 JUDGE STEARLEY: Thank you, Mr. Zobrist. 5 And for KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations б Company? 7 MR. ZOBRIST: And I am same as the above, except for Mr. Brewer would be Ms. Buffington and myself. 8 9 JUDGE STEARLEY: Okay. And Kansas City Power and Light, do we have anything on the phone for 10 KCP&L? 11 12 MR. ZOBRIST: That would, again, be Ms. Buffington and me. 13 14 JUDGE STEARLEY: All right. 15 And who do I have on the phone participating? 16 17 (No response.) JUDGE STEARLEY: We did have a caller from 18 KCP&L. Did we lose our caller? 19 20 MR. FRERKING: This is Don Frerking, Kansas 21 City Power and Light. 22 JUDGE STEARLEY: Okay. Thank you very much. Just wanted to get your name in the record there. 23 24 For the Missouri Industrial Energy 25 Consumers?

Page 7 1 (No response.) JUDGE STEARLEY: Let the record reflect 2 3 there's no entry from MIEC, unless we have someone come in 4 the door. 5 MR. MILLS: It's one of mine. б JUDGE STEARLEY: For the Office of the 7 Public Counsel? 8 MR. MILLS: On behalf of the Office of 9 Public Counsel and the Public, my name is Lewis Mills. My address is Post Office Box 2230, Jefferson City, Missouri, 10 65102. 11 12 JUDGE STEARLEY: Thank you. And for the Staff of Missouri Public 13 Service? 14 MR. DOTTHEIM: Steven Dottheim, Nathan 15 Williams, Goldie Thompson, Meghan McClowry, Amy Moore, 16 Post Office Box 360, Jefferson City, Missouri, 65102, 17 appearing on behalf of the Staff of the Missouri Public 18 Service Commission. 19 20 JUDGE STEARLEY: All right. Thank you, Mr. Dottheim. 21 22 Are there any matters we need to take up on the record this morning? 23 24 MR. ZOBRIST: None from the companies, 25 Judge.

Page 8 JUDGE STEARLEY: Mr. Dottheim, I believe 1 you expressed some concern regarding my initial order on a 2 3 Staff recommendation? MR. DOTTHEIM: Yes, Judge. You had 4 indicated you were looking for a Staff -- a Staff 5 6 recommendation on November 5th. Pardon me. And I 7 indicated that on behalf of the Staff that I thought that was a bit quick. 8 9 I was thinking that the likely reason you were convening the pre-hearing conference today was the 10 purpose of discussing a procedural schedule and the Staff 11 12 was thinking that it would need some time beyond November 5th for the purpose of coming up with a -- a Staff 13 14 recommendation. Under normal circumstances, the Staff would 15 need additional time. In particular, the Staff needs 16 17 additional time given the various rate cases that are occurring and the demands of those rate cases on Staff 18 19 resources. 20 The Staff submitted its first set of data 21 requests to Transource Missouri and KCPL, GMO -- G-M-O --22 this is KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company, late Friday, Friday evening; and, given that the Staff 23 24 submitted those late Friday afternoon into Friday evening, the Staff wouldn't expect that the time would start 25

Page 9 running on a response for those data requests until today. 1 So, the Staff wouldn't expect the 20 days to start until 2 3 today, that is as if the data requests were actually served today. 4 5 So, given the other demands on the Staff, 6 sometime the Staff has served its first data request today 7 _ _ JUDGE STEARLEY: All right. 8 9 MR. DOTTHEIM: -- so, the Staff has started its discovery. And, frankly, the Staff wants to discuss 10 today with Transource and KCPL GMO the proposed schedule 11 12 that even the companies proposed in the EO-2012-0367 case which the Staff believes is a bit expeditious given the 13 14 other demands and the nature of the cases. JUDGE STEARLEY: Okay. That's not a 15 problem at all, Mr. Dottheim. 16 And in terms of procedural schedule, you 17 18 don't necessarily act on the full proceedings of schedule. 19 I don't know if these matters will be contested in any way 20 or not, so if you could file a status report next Monday 21 and just kind of letting me know what you all have worked 22 out and proposing your date of some type of a Staff recommendation, or if you need time to conduct more of an 23 24 investigation first, we can just cancel that date and you can file a subsequent status report later. 25

Page 10 MR. ZOBRIST: Judge, we've told the Staff 1 that we would like to develop a procedural schedule in the 2 case and, of course, we have no objection to status 3 reports. We've also told Mr. Dottheim that the companies 4 5 understand that the proposal they made in the first case, 6 the EO-2012-0367 case needs some work. 7 It was proposed, you know, without regard to other proceedings that are going on, and I'm told Mr. 8 9 Dottheim would work with Public Staff, other Public 10 Counsel, and another person to modify that, but to keep on a schedule, but we certainly have, you know, discussed 11 12 extensions. 13 Our proposal -- this was not a hard and 14 fast proposal. We just wanted to kind of communicate what we were thinking in terms of general time lines. 15 JUDGE STEARLEY: Okay. Well, if you can 16 17 formalize a schedule and file it next Monday, that would be great. And I brought a copy of our adjudication 18 19 calender with us, so that might be helpful for you. 20 MR. ZOBRIST: Great. Thank you. 21 MR. DOTTHEIM: Judge, when I took a look at 22 the adjudication schedule, yes, that -- yeah -- doesn't reflect -- it seems -- uh, no. It doesn't have built in 23 24 to it the Empire case. 25 JUDGE STEARLEY: I don't know if that's

Page 11 been posted on there or not. If it's not, I will go talk 1 to the secretaries upstairs and make sure it gets put on. 2 3 MR. DOTTHEIM: Okay. The Empire. 4 JUDGE STEARLEY: Okay. 5 MR. DOTTHEIM: Okay. The Empire rate case. 6 JUDGE STEARLEY: Is it -- that's coming up 7 in February? MR. DOTTHEIM: Yes. 8 9 JUDGE STEARLEY: Okay. 10 MR. DOTTHEIM: Yes. MR. ZOBRIST: During February? 11 12 MR. DOTTHEIM: Yes. The adjudication schedule is completely clear from January, starting in 13 14 January. 15 JUDGE STEARLEY: Okay. MR. DOTTHEIM: Starting January 1, there is 16 17 nothing posted. JUDGE STEARLEY: All right. I will check 18 19 into that. All right. 20 Is there anything else we need to take up? 21 MR. ZOBRIST: I was going to say we had 22 told the Judge on the GMO Steam (ph) complaint case, when Mr. Conrad and I were trying to figure out what was going 23 24 on, we couldn't get much more than two months ahead on the website. So, I think the Adjudication Division is taking 25

Page 12 steps to let at least the outsiders know what's happening 1 in the next six months. 2 3 JUDGE STEARLEY: That should now be 4 extended for six months. But, if we don't have the items 5 on there, it's still not helpful. 6 MR. DOTTHEIM: Yeah. And, even on -- on 7 the Commission's Internet website, I went -- I went to that to check, and that -- it's the same thing. 8 9 JUDGE STEARLEY: Okay. 10 MR. DOTTHEIM: It's -- for example, Empire's not on. In fact, it's -- it's clear like from 11 12 January on. It is just clear. JUDGE STEARLEY: I will go talk to them 13 about that as soon as I leave here. 14 15 MR. DOTTHEIM: Okay. Thank you. 16 JUDGE STEARLEY: No. That's no problem. 17 Anything else. 18 (No response.) 19 JUDGE STEARLEY: All right. We'll go ahead 20 and conclude the on-the-record portion of this, and I look 21 forward to seeing the schedule next week. 22 (Adjournment.) 23 (Whereupon, the record ended at 9:14 a.m.) 24 * * * * * 25
