ORDER ESTABLISHING PROTECTIVE ORDER

This order grants the request for the Commission's standard protective order.

On May 3, 2005, Damon Andersson filed a complaint against Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE. AmerenUE answered the complaint, denying Mr. Andersson's allegations. The Commission ordered its Staff to investigate, and to file a report.

On July 6, Staff filed its report and Motion for Protective Order. Staff alleged that material within its report contains information regarding specific customers and, as such, that information is entitled to a protective order under Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.085.

Upon review of the motion, the Commission finds that there is a need to protect confidential information and the request for a protective order is reasonable. The Commission has previously recognized the need to protect confidential information, and protective orders have helped minimize disputes in past cases. Therefore, the Commission concludes that a protective order should be granted.
